- I. It's worth noting that many of the catchment area enrollment K-12 and high school numbers may be estimates based on data shared with the directors in recent years.
- II. AOE State CTE Director, Ruth Durkee, has said she can send the numbers for K-12 and high school enrollment in catchment areas by Monday, 4/7/2025.
- III. All centers have been emailed requests for enrollment numbers and waitlist or open spots numbers except for Canaan Technical Center and Missisquoi UHSD #7.
 - A. Seven have responded so far with full data, some data, or the promise to send data.
- IV. Patricia A. Hannaford Career Center, Nicole MacTavish, Director:
 - A. PAHCC is also working on a spreadsheet of much of the same data as this report covering all CTE in Vermont. Director MacTavish says she and her Assistant Director would be happy to sit down with Chair Marcotte and share what they have collected so far.
- V. Missisquoi provides state approved agriculture programs only and only to Missisquoi students, according to Ruth Durkee. In their program of studies this is listed as Cooperative Technical Education (CTE).
- VI. There are five centers providing full time programs, ten centers providing half time programs, and two centers providing half time programs along with one or a few full time programs.
