



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
Mission Statement:

SUD & Incarceration

Opioid Use Disorder


- Two-thirds of Vermont's incarcerated population has a diagnosed opioid use disorder.
- Vermont DOC is among the state's largest providers of addiction treatment.
- Overdose is the leading cause of death for people recently released from incarceration nationwide.

Research

- People who have been incarcerated in state prisons are up to 129 times more likely to die from an overdose.
- Increased community-based substance use treatment capacity is associated with decreases in both jail admissions and overdose deaths.
- Vermont has made strides in reducing overdose deaths for justice-involved Vermonters:
- Among individuals with OUD released from incarceration, nonfatal overdoses decreased by one-third and fatal overdoses fell by more than 60%.



Community-Based Peer Coaching



Peer Coaching via Recovery Partners of Vermont Member Sites

- Scaled Rutland pilot statewide
 - Supported with \$500,000 in BAA and \$1M in OSAC funds
- In-reach peer recovery coaching with co-located recovery centers.
 - Continuity of care: Individuals able to access recovery services
- across institutional and jurisdictional boundaries.

Q3 Correctional Facility-based Coaching:

- Group meetings: 121
- Individual coaching sessions: 389
- Individuals served: 1,301

Q3 Probation and Parole Coaching:

- Group meetings: 109
- Individual coaching sessions: 652
- Individuals served: 926



Budget

Recovery Partners of Vermont & DOC Joint Partnership

- Peer coaching staffing x18 sites (6 facilities/12 P&P): \$940,050
Benefits/fringe: \$104,450
Total personnel costs: \$1,044,500
- Non-personnel/operating costs: \$18,000
\$1,000 x18 sites
Total direct costs: \$1,062,500
- Indirect costs (10% Admin): \$187,500
- Total annual project cost: \$1,250,000
