2 Representatives Burrows of West Windsor and LaMont of Morristown
3 move that the bill be amended as follows:

4 First: In Sec. 1, 16 V.S.A. chapter 25, subchapter 3, in subdivision
5 1123(a)(11), following “or legal guardian;” by striking out the word “or”

6 Second: In Sec. 1, 16 V.S.A. chapter 25, subchapter 3, in subsection
7 1123(a), by striking out subdivision (12) in its entirety and inserting in lieu
8 thereof a new subdivision (12) and a subdivision (13) to read as follows:

9 (12) incidents of hazing, harassment, or bullying; or

10 (13) other reasons not specified in subdivisions (1)–(12) of this
11 subsection with approval of the superintendent of a public school or designee
12 or the head of school of an approved independent school or designee.

13 Third: In Sec. 1, 16 V.S.A. chapter 25, subchapter 3, in subsection 1124(a),
14 following the words “prevention of chronic absenteeism and truancy” by
15 inserting “, which shall include guidance that emphasizes the importance of
16 tailored responses to all students struggling with safety and emotional issues
17 and shall emphasize emotional, academic, and social support to facilitate a
18 successful reintegration for returning students. The policy shall include
19 protocols to respond effectively to bullying and harassment, acknowledging
20 the unique aspects of each case, including best practices for reentry into
21 education spaces”
