## What follows are current year funding levels for the three education formula grant programs administered by AOE. Included with each amount are brief descriptions of these programs as well for clarity. ESEA – \$68.5M

Title IA \$42,724,415 (Program to improve academic achievement of disadvantaged students – often used for reading and math learning specialists and literacy and math coaching services, as well as curricular materials)

Title IIA \$ 10, 835,611 (Program that supports teacher professional development activities and activities to promote recruitment and retention of effective educators)

Title III \$500,000 (English language learner instructional services and supports)

Title IVA \$6,659,535 (Safe and healthy schools and "well-rounded education" program – is often used for mental health and family engagement services in schools)

Title IVB- \$6,515,398 (21c summer and afterschool programming)

MV \$322,500 (Educational services and supports for continuity of education for homeless children and youth – is often used for transportation when a child has moved due to homelessness)

Migrant \$ \$674,116 (Educational services and supports to children meeting the "migrant" definition)

## IDEA B - \$37.5M

\$37,553,494 (Supports and services to students ages 3-22 who have been identified as having special needs. Part C funding for supports and services for infants and toddlers with disabilities is not included in this number.)

## Perkins - \$5.9M

\$5,909,176 (Supports for career and technical education programs)
