





Supervisory Unions: administrative, planning, and educational service units created by the State Board

Supervisory Unions can be made up of multiple school districts or just one school district:

Supervisory Union (multi school districts)

Supervisory District (one school district)





16 V.S.A. 261a. Duties of supervisory union board:

- Establish SU-wide curriculum
- Receipt and disbursement of federal and State funds distributed by AOE
- Professional development
- Special education services
- Provision of several services, including procurement, management of construction projects, negotiate teacher contracts, transportation, etc.

School Districts: town school districts, union school districts, interstate school districts, city school districts, unified union school districts, and incorporated school districts, each of which is governed by a publicly elected board

- ▶ There are several different types of school districts, dependent on:
- the number of towns the school district serves
 - One town?
 - Multiple towns? (union school districts)
- the grades for which the school district is organized to provide education for
 - All grades prek-12?
 - If a school district serves multiple towns = unified union school district
 - Some subset of all grades?
 - If a school district serves multiple towns = union elementary school district or union high school district, depending on the grades
- how the school district provides education for those grades
 - Does it operate its own schools for all grades it is organized to provide education for?

School Districts


16 V.S.A. 563. Powers of school boards


- Set educational policies of the school district
- May take any action that is required for the sound administration of the school district
- ▶ Shall have the possession, care, control, and management of the property of the district
- ▶ Shall keep school buildings and grounds in good repair
- Discretion to administer early educational programs
- May relocate or discontinue use of a schoolhouse or facility, subject to applicable law
- Budget
- May execute contracts
- ▶ Shall exercise the general powers given to a legislative branch of a municipality



 - Pk-6: Shaftsbury Elementary School; Woodford Hollow Elementary School; Pownal Elementary School
 - Bennington
 - Pk-5: Bennington Elementary School, Molly Stark Elementary School, Monument Elementary School
- ▶ Mt. Anthony Union School District:
 - Pownal, Woodford, Shaftsbury, North Bennington, Bennington
 - ▶ Mt. Anthony Union Middle School (6-8)
 - ▶ Mt. Anthony Union High School (9-12 all towns)
- North Bennington School District
 - Non operational: Tuition Pk-6
- ► Arlington School District
 - ► Fisher Elementary School (Pk-5)
 - ► Arlington Memorial High School (6-12)
- Sandgate School District
 - Non operational: Tuition Pk-12
