


Task Force on Collaboration to Benefit All Students: Key Findings and Recommendations



Background:

- Task Force formed and staffed by the VSBA following a member-adopted resolution
- Purpose: Assess persistent concerns with the State Board of Education and the Agency of Education and provide the Governor and legislature with a list of recommended actions
- Goal: Improve leadership, governance, and outcomes in public education.
- Timeline: Monthly meetings January-September 2024
 - Final report with actionable recommendations issued September 2024

Key Findings – Data Accessibility

- Lack of thorough, timely, accurate, and publicly accessible educational data.
- Recommendation: Develop & maintain comprehensive data dashboard to ensure transparency and inform decision-making.





Key Findings - Agency of Education Capacity

- Persistent underperformance in fulfilling responsibilities, including policy execution and compliance monitoring.
- Recommendation: Conduct organizational review of the AOE to improve staffing, resources, and operational capacity.



Key Findings - State Board of Education

- Lack of governance structure, independence, and resources necessary to meet its statutory obligations and to provide effective leadership and oversight.
- Recommendations: Restructure SBE to ensure non-partisan leadership & adequate support for good governance. Require the SBE to apply the DQS to their work; provide adequate legal and technical assistance.

Key Findings - Existing Legislation

- New laws and insufficient capacity to implement them = recurring policy failures.
- Recommendation: Focus on implementation of current policies before advancing new initiatives.
 Require regular reporting on progress toward effective implementation of various policy initiatives.

Key Findings - Support Public Education

- Commission on the Future of Public Education is critical for sustainability and governance.
- Recommendation: Align efforts with the Commission to ensure comprehensive improvements.

 Task Force recommendations are launching points for future work

Outcome: Strengthened public education system delivering equitable, high-quality educational opportunities for Vermont students.
