

A summary of my comments today:

- Findings all look accurate and complete; helpful in understanding the entirety of issue
- P 3, starting at line 8, (d)...earlier discussion included a requirement for notice to be sent to the Public Service Department and to the Enhanced 911 Board. I am not seeing a reference to the 911 Board in this language?
- All of the requirements for the notification seem appropriate - nothing to add here at this point, but will be watching for the suggested edits that Hunter Thompson will be providing.
- P 5, line 8, (d)...the reports we collect from originating service providers and electric power companies may provide a high level view of towns/communities that have been impacted by various types of outages, but to be clear - they provide only a town level view, not specific addresses within the community that are impacted.
- Originating Service Provider/Electric Service Provider Outage Reports: The reports are for situational awareness purposes and to have a general sense of where outages are occurring. The originating service provider reports (from telcos) are distributed as they are received to VEM, the six Public Safety Answering Points, and any dispatch center or first response agency that has requested them.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the draft. I'll continue to monitor it as it develops.

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
