4	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to revise the
5	reporting requirements required of the Agency of Digital Services and to
6	require the Agency to provide a publicly available dashboard containing
7	information about certain information technology projects.
8	An act relating to the Agency of Digital Services
9	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
10	Sec. 1. 3 V.S.A. § 3303 is amended to read:
11	§ 3303. REPORTING, RECORDS, AND REVIEW REQUIREMENTS
12	(a) Annual report and budget. The Secretary shall submit to the General
13	Assembly, concurrent with the Governor's annual budget request required
14	under 32 V.S.A. § 306, an annual report for information technology and
15	cybersecurity. The report shall reflect the priorities of the Agency and shall
16	include:
17	(1) performance metrics and trends, including baseline and annual
18	measurements, for each division of the Agency and the extent to which the
19	projects in subdivision (4) of this subsection have met their business goals;

1	(2) a financial report of revenues and expenditures to date for the current
2	fiscal year;
3	(3) costs avoided or saved as a result of technology optimization for the
4	previous fiscal year;
5	(4) an outline summary of information, including scope, schedule
6	original and current estimated date of completion, original and current
7	estimated budget, and status for information technology projects with total
8	costs of \$500,000.00 or greater;
9	(5) an annual update to the strategic plan prepared pursuant to
10	subsection (c) of this section;
11	(6) a summary of independent reviews as required by subsection (d) of
12	this section, including any uses of the waiver authority by the Chief
13	<u>Information Officer pursuant to subdivision (d)(3) of this section;</u>
14	(7) the Agency budget submission;
15	(8) an annual update to the inventory required by section 3305 of this
16	title; and-
17	(9) a report on the expenditures of the Technology Modernization
18	Special Fund, a list of projects receiving funding from the Fund in the prior
19	fiscal year, and a list of prioritized recommendations for projects to be funded
20	from the Fund in the next fiscal year.

1	(b) Records. The Agency shall maintain the following records for
2	information technology projects with a total cost of \$500,000.00 or greater:
3	(1) A business case, including life-cycle costs and client-entity staffing
4	costs and sources of funds for design, development, and implementation, as
5	well as maintenance and operations. The business case shall include expected
6	benefits, including cost savings and service delivery improvements.
7	* * *
8	(d) Independent expert review.
9	(1) The Agency shall obtain independent expert review of any new
10	information technology projects with a total cost of \$1,000,000.00 or greater or
11	when required by the Chief Information Officer.
12	(2) The independent review shall include:
13	(A) an acquisition cost assessment;
14	(B) a technology architecture and standards review;
15	(C) an implementation plan assessment;
16	(D) a cost analysis and a model for benefit analysis;
17	(E) an analysis of alternatives;
18	(F) an impact analysis on net operating costs for the agency carrying
19	out the activity; and
20	(G) a security assessment.

1	(3) The requirement to obtain independent expert review described in
2	subdivision (1) of this subsection (d) may be waived by the Chief Information
3	Officer if, in his or her the Chief Information Officer's judgment, such a
4	review would be duplicative of one or more reviews that have been, or will be,
5	conducted under a separate federal or State requirement. If waived, such
6	waiver shall be in writing and in accordance with procedures established by the
7	Chief Information Officer.
8	(e) Current projects dashboard. The Agency shall maintain a project
9	dashboard on its publicly accessible website that provides the status of all
10	current information technology projects with a total estimated cost of
11	\$500,000.00 or greater. The dashboard shall include the:
12	(1) name of the agency and department that each project is directed
13	towards;
14	(2) name of each project;
15	(3) actual start date, including the planning or initiation phase, of each
16	project;
17	(4) original estimated start date of the execution phase of each project;
18	(5) original estimated date of completion of each project;
19	(6) original estimated cost of each project;
20	(7) actual start date of the execution phase of each project;

1	(8) current estimated date of completion, including a timestamp of when
2	this date was last revised and, if this date is different from subdivision (5) of
3	this subsection, an explanation of why the date has changed;
4	(9) current estimated cost of each project, including a timestamp of
5	when this amount was last revised and, if this amount is different from
6	subdivision (6) of this subsection, an explanation of why the amount has
7	changed;
8	(10) difference between subdivisions (5) and (8) of this subsection,
9	shown in a percentage format; and
10	(11) difference between subdivisions (6) and (9) of this subsection,
11	shown in a percentage format.
12	(f) Completed projects dashboard. The Agency shall maintain a project
13	dashboard on its publicly accessible website that provides the history of all
14	completed information technology projects with a total completed cost of
15	\$500,000.00 or greater. The dashboard shall include the:
16	(1) name of the agency and department that each project was directed
17	towards;
18	(2) name of each project;
19	(3) actual start date, including the planning or initiation phase, of each
20	project;

1	(4) original estimated and actual start date of the execution phase of
2	each project;
3	(5) original estimated and actual date of completion of each project, and
4	the difference between the two dates shown in percentage format; and
5	(6) original estimated and actual cost of each project, and the difference
6	between the two amounts shown in percentage format.
7	Sec. 2. IMPLEMENTATION OF PROJECT DASHBOARDS
8	The project dashboards the Agency of Digital Services is required to
9	product pursuant to subsections 32 V.S.A. § 3303(e) and (f) shall be
10	operational on or before July 1, 2025. The current projects dashboard shall
11	show all information technology projects that are in planning or operational
12	phases, including those that started before the effective date of this act. The
13	completed projects dashboard shall show all projects the Agency has
14	completed on or after X.
15	Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
16	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
