8	§ 8012. ENERGY TRANSITION ECONOMIC IMPACTS REPORT
9	(a) On or before January 15 of each year, the Department of Public Service,
10	in consultation with relevant State agencies, shall analyze and report on
11	Vermont's clean energy transition, which shall include identifying regional
12	energy access gaps, tracking costs, and reviewing workforce development.
13	(b) The report shall include:
14	(1) the number of gas stations operating within the State and if there was
15	any change in the number in the prior year;
16	(2) the number of heating fuel sellers operating in the State, the volume
17	of heating fuels delivered in bulk by those sellers, and if there was any change
18	in the number and volume in the prior year;
19	(3) the number of electric vehicle supply equipment in the State and if
20	there was any change in the number in the prior year;
21	(4) electric rates and whether there were any changes;

1	(5) the number of renewable energy development companies operating
2	within the State; and
3	(6) maps showing the data required in this subsection (b).
4	(c) The State agencies that collect data related to the topics in subsection
5	(b) of this section shall provide the Department with relevant data for this
6	report.
7	(d) For the report due January 15, 2026, the Department shall include data
8	from the past five years.
9	(e) The provisions of 2 V.S.A. § 20(d) shall not apply to this report.
10	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
