

Hi, I would like to express my interest in keeping Advanced metering infrastructure device (aka Smart Meter) opt-out free.

I do not want extra wireless transmission infrastructure running 24/7 right next to my house (where I spend most of my time).

I also do not want my children exposed to these extra un-necessary wireless transmissions.

We currently opt out of wireless electric meters and self-report to the VT Electric Coop monthly.

There is no telling how much they would try to charge for a non-smart meter, but it could be a lot, and adding extra monthly fees could get expensive too.

Perhaps you should read the insert next time you buy a new phone or other wireless device. Also you may not realize but there has been no significant research done by Federal authorities on the impact of wireless transmissions on humans for almost 30 years (since before cell phones were prevalent).

They have done research in other countries and there are lots of reports of the fact that these transmissions can impact human health, especially over long-term usage.

The existing non-fee rules are fair and non-discriminatory because they do not exclude people who choose to play it safe until proper long term safety research can be done.

Furthermore I am personally sensitive to wireless transmissions and don't want to live next to something that transmits 24/7.
