Where we were ...

- Legacy system BFIS (Bright Futures Information System)
 - Housed the Child Care Financial Assistance Program (CCFAP) including eligibility determination and provider payroll
 - Currently houses Child Care Licensing and Child Care Provider Workforce
- Created 25+ years ago
- Outdated platform no longer vendor-supported and proven to be inadequate
- Prone to errors and limited capacity to take on new functionality
- As a result, not to able to make all federally-mandated or legislatively-directed changes

- Planning for CDDIS started in 2018
- Project managed by Agency of Digital Services (ADS) with extensive Child Development Division (CDD) involvement
- “CDDIS Phase 1” Child Care Financial Assistance Program (CCFAP)
 - Eligibility determination
 - Provider payments
- Brite System – Vendor/contractor Phase 1
- Salesforce platform
- Went live with CDDIS on July 3rd, 2022
- MVP (minimum viable product)

CDDIS Phase 1

Continuation of system build and functionality

Ease of use / process

Fixing bugs

Act 76 changes

Increased eligibility in two phases ($\geq 400\%$ FPL and $\geq 575\%$ FPL)

Expanded enrollment vs attendance rules

Created an on-line application

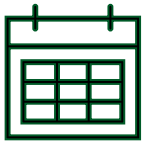
Increased provider rates in two phases

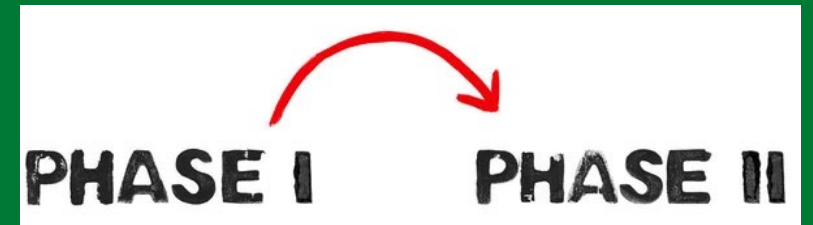

CDDIS – Phase 2



Child Care Licensing and Credentialing

- Creating the Request for Proposals (RFP) – estimated posting March 2025
 - Current budget for Phase 2 = \$3.7M
 - (\$3M GF + ~\$700K annual set aside of Child Care Financial Development Fund)
 - Child Care Provider case management system that will integrate with CDDIS Phase 1
 - Child Care Licensing Management
 - Program licensing and renewal
 - Complaint and compliance management
 - Ability to meet federal compliance – currently out-of-compliance in some areas
 - User friendliness for parents, providers, and staff
 - Child Care Provider and Staff Credential Management System
 - Workforce management
 - Continued learning management
