Subject: Review of Governor's Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Adjustment Proposal

The House Appropriations Committee is taking testimony from agencies and departments regarding the Governor's fiscal year 2025 budget adjustment recommendation. The goal is to conclude budget testimony on Friday, January 24. The House Appropriations Committee requests input from the standing committees on or before Thursday, January 23rd. For your information, the committee has scheduled a public hearing on the Governor's proposal on January 23rd from 1 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.
