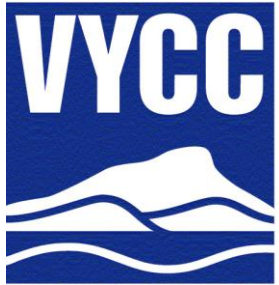

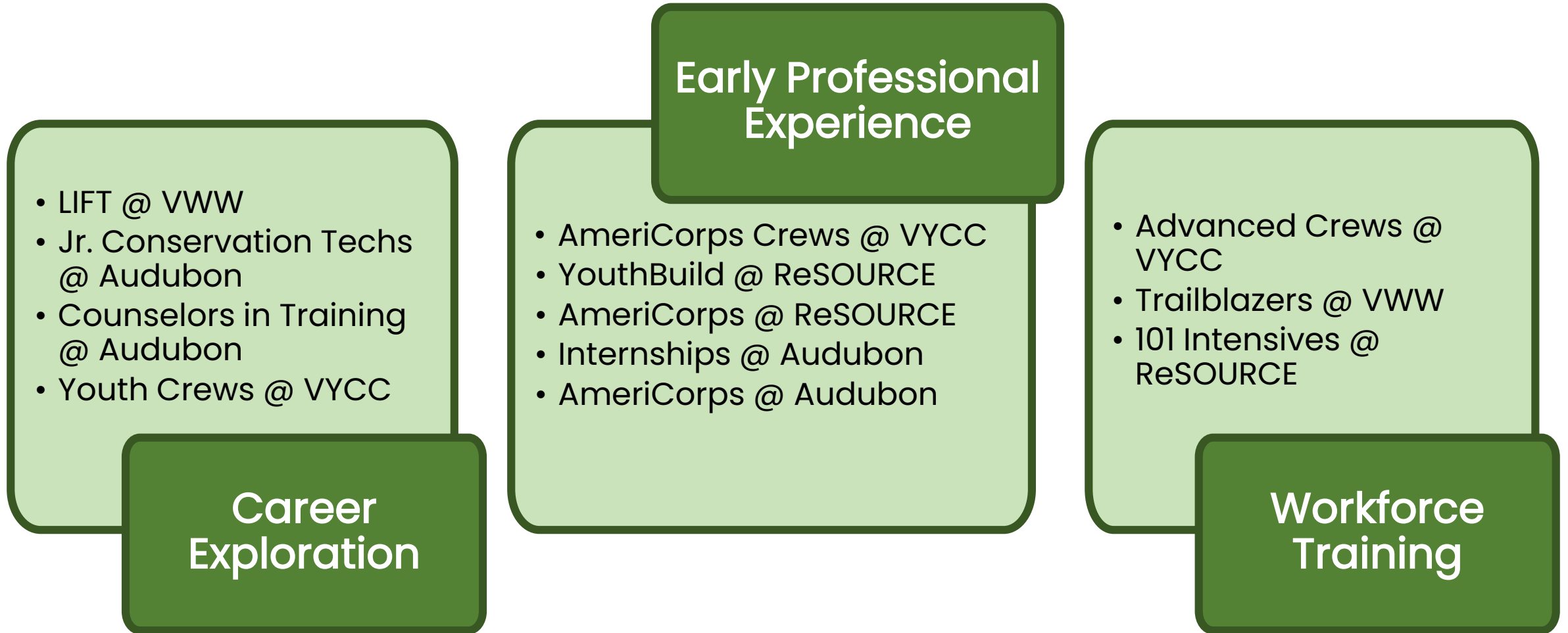

- Audubon Vermont: Junior Conservation Technician Program
  - HS-aged students gain exposure to conservation careers including forester, biologist, and land manager.
  - Complete service projects on public trail system in Huntington





# Early Professional Experience

- Vermont Youth Conservation Corps Farm & Conservation Crews (including AmeriCorps position)
  - Extended service opportunities in sustainable agriculture, forestry, trail building, outdoor infrastructure building, and water quality.
  - Credentials of Value: OSHA-10, Game of Logging, Wilderness First Aid





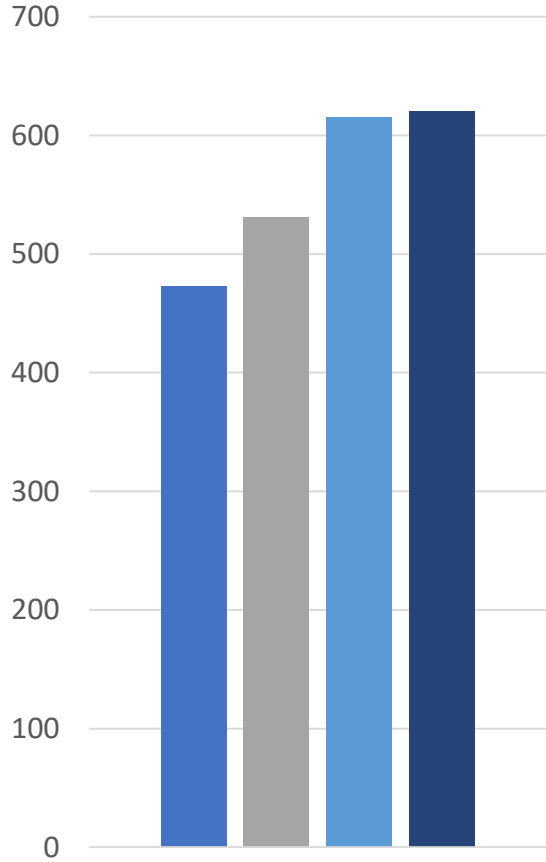
# Workforce Training

- ReSOURCE's 101 Intensive Training Courses
  - Construction, HVAC, Weatherization, Heavy Equipment
  - Full-time training program- 4 weeks of training/service, 2 weeks of employer-based work experience.
  - OSHA-10, NCCER, EPA 608
- Vermont Works for Women's Trailblazer Program
  - 7-week program; nights & weekend, 2 week employer-based work experience
  - Focus on construction, electrical, plumbing, solar install, HVAC.
  - OSHA-10, EPA 608



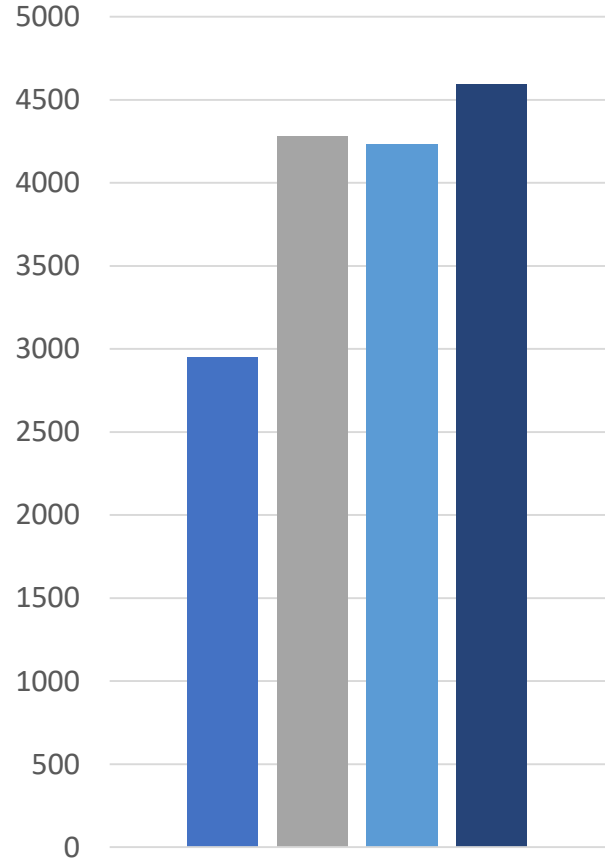

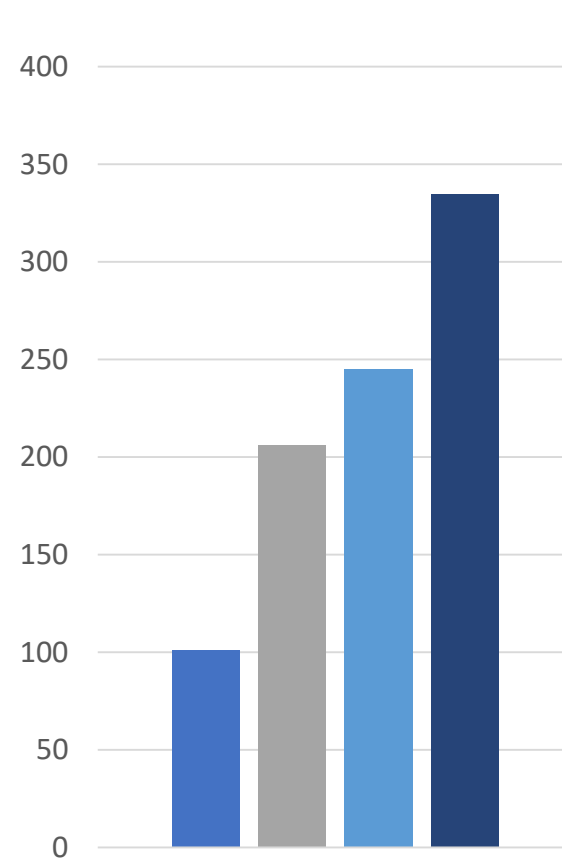

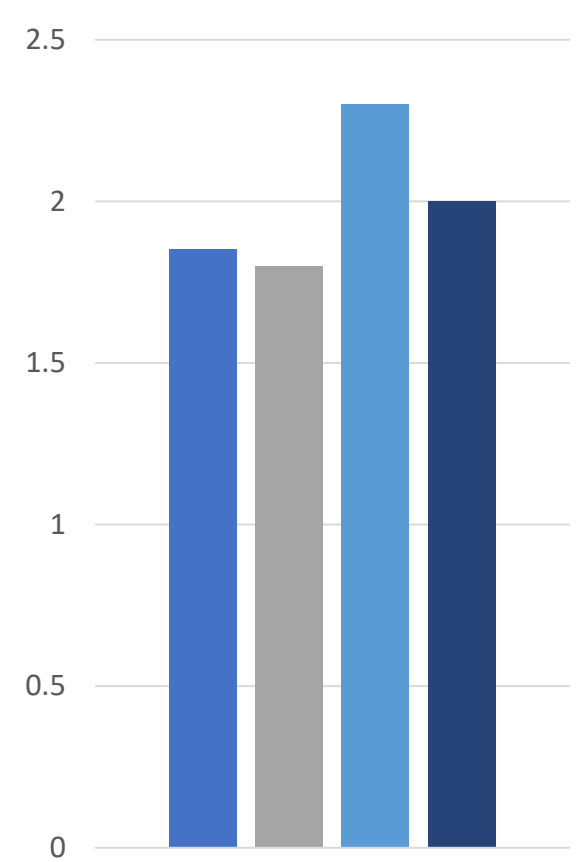
Service & Training Weeks

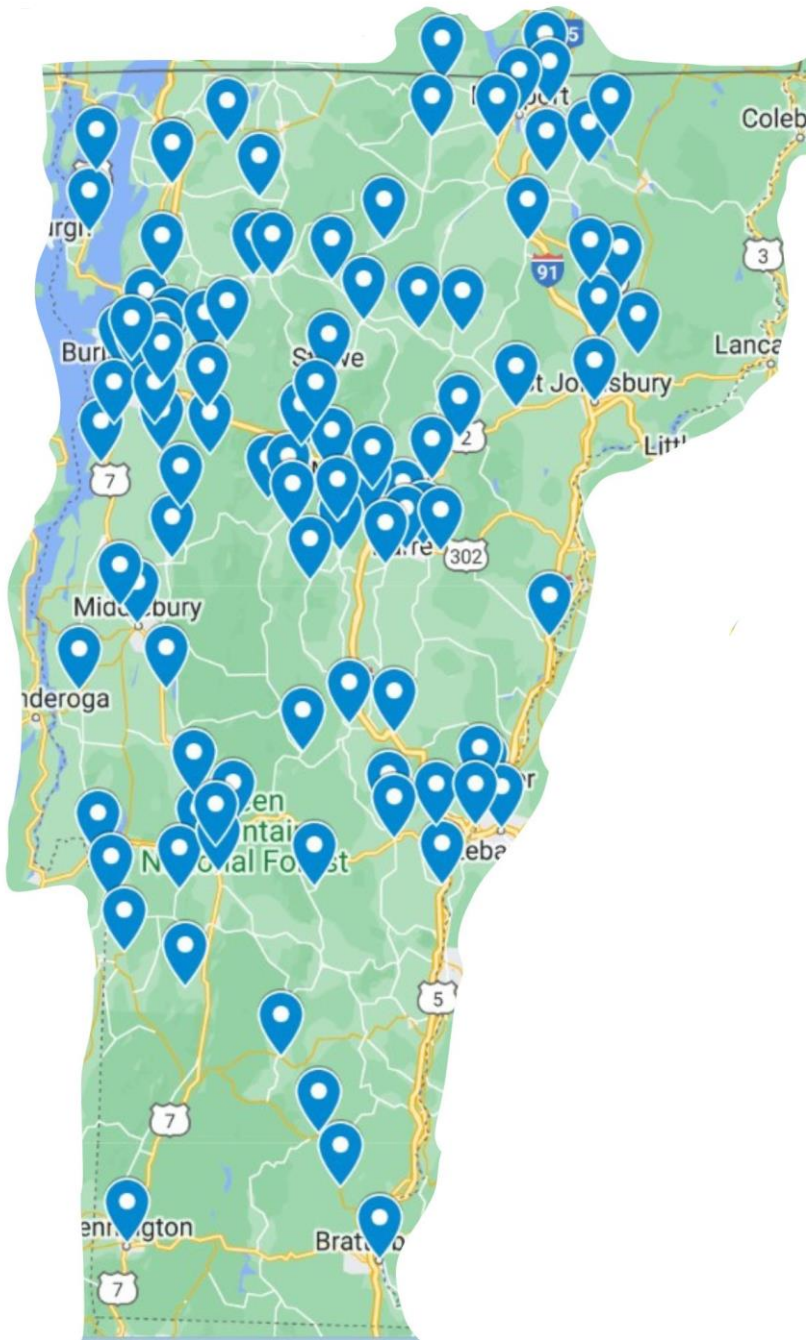


Public Funding (M)

615 participants (70% are 15-24 years old)

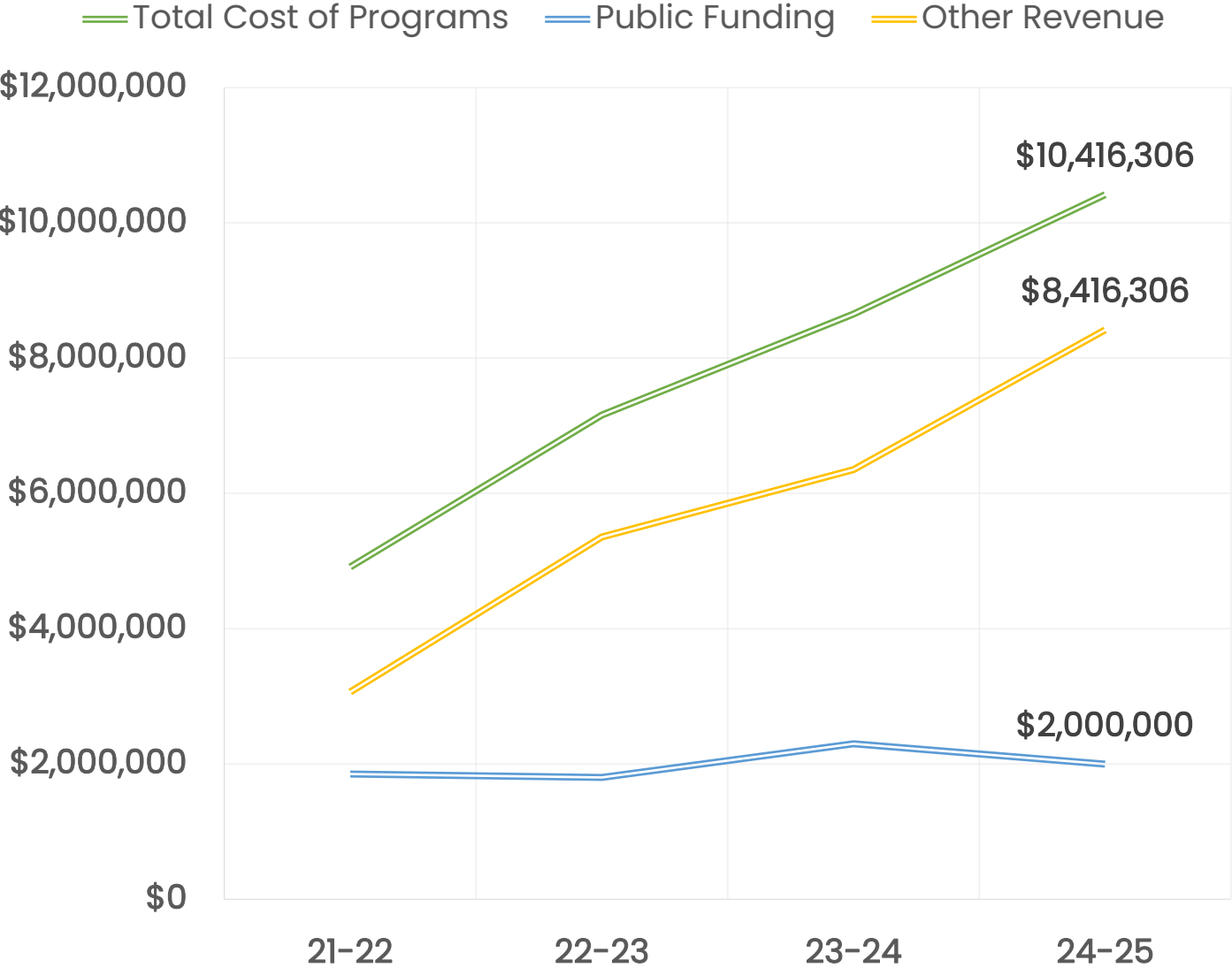
62% of trainees seeking employment were offered a job upon graduation

# SLE BUDGET



Serve Learn Earn Partners pursue private philanthropy and federal funding sources to maintain and grow programs.

- Received 3-year \$1.8M grant from the Ascendium Foundation.
- Pursuing Workforce Opportunity for Rural Community (WORC) Initiative Funding through Northern Borders Regional Commission this spring.
- Our FY25 budget request is the same we had last year, \$2.5M in the base budget of FPR.
