2 Representative Canfield of Fair Haven moves that House concur in the
3 Senate proposal of amendment with the further proposal of amendment by
4 striking out Sec. 13, effective dates, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof
5 a new Sec. 13 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 13. EFFECTIVE DATES

7 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2026, except that:

8 (1) in Sec. 1, 10 V.S.A. § 1522(b) (handling fees for redemption of
9 containers) shall take effect on January 1, 2027;

10 (2) in Sec. 1, 10 V.S.A. § 1524(c) (requiring a UPC label on containers)
11 shall take effect on July 1, 2027;

12 (3) in Sec. 1, 10 V.S.A. § 1531(a) (prohibiting sale or distribution
13 without participating in the producer responsibility organization) shall take
14 effect on July 1, 2027;

15 (4) Sec. 2 (acceptance of beverage containers after plan implementation)
16 shall take effect on March 1, 2029;

17 (5) in Sec. 5, 10 V.S.A. § 6618(b)(11) (capital implementation grants)
18 shall take effect on July 1, 2029; and

19 (6) Sec. 7 (repeal of handling fees under the beverage container
20 stewardship plan) shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
