



State-Level Land Bank Roles

- 1. State lands repository / agent / (re)developer.
- 2. Distressed properties in inventory.
- 3. Support for / to local land banks and governments.
- 4. Intake of properties to position for (re)development.
- 5. Standardize / systemize land banking activities.
