We support the Administration's FY27 budget recommendation for Vermont's Regional Planning Commissions and recognize the fiscal pressures facing the state.

RPCs are managing increased workloads to support housing implementation, municipal capacity, and emergency preparedness, even as key funding sources decline. The loss of FEMA emergency management funding is expected to continue into FY27, while rural municipalities are increasingly turning to RPCs for assistance exploring shared service models to maintain service quality and control increasing costs.

We appreciate your support for the essential role RPCs play in supporting housing growth, strengthening local governments, and maintaining emergency preparedness across Vermont.
