1	TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
2	The Committee on Government Operations and Military Affairs to which
3	was referred House Bill No. 233 entitled "An act relating to requirements for
4	State-funded grants" respectfully reports that it has considered the same and
5	recommends that the bill be amended by striking out all after the enacting
6	clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
7	Sec. 1. STATE GRANTS RECOMMENDATIONS
8	(a) On or before December 15, 2025, the entities listed in this subsection
9	shall submit to the House Committees on Government Operations and Military
10	Affairs and on Appropriations and the Senate Committees on Government
11	Operations and on Appropriations findings and recommendations for statutory
12	changes, changes to Administrative Bulletin 5, or both, on the issues identified
13	in subsection (b) of this section. The following entities shall work together to
14	develop the recommendations:
15	(1) the Secretary of Administration or designee;
16	(2) a representative of Common Good Vermont; and
17	(3) a representative of the Vermont Association of Planning and
18	Development Agencies.
19	(b) The entities shall develop recommendations for Administrative Bulletin
20	5, Policy for Grant Issuance and Monitoring, on:

1	(1) a requirement that all State agencies accept indirect rates approved
2	by a Federal or State agency;
3	(2) a uniform indirect rate calculation methodology and approval
4	process for use in all State-administered grants for nonprofit corporations of
5	the State higher than the standard de minimis rate, pursuant to 2 C.F.R.
6	§ 200.332(b)(4); and
7	(3) a provision that whenever the Secretary or designee of a State
8	agency determines that another agency or political subdivision of the State is
9	uniquely suited to deliver certain services, the State agency shall award a grant
10	to that agency or political subdivision of the State in lieu of compliance with
11	any bidding requirements otherwise established by rule or law.
12	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
13	This act shall take effect on passage.
