Re: Input on H.237, An act relating to prescribing by doctoral-level psychologists

- 1. This is to share the position of the Board of Medical Practice on H.237, An act relating to prescribing by doctoral-level psychologists.
- 2. This afternoon H.237 was added to the agenda for the House Health Care Committee for tomorrow morning and again on Friday morning. The agenda for Friday indicates "*Review and Possible Vote*." Neither I nor the Chair of the Board of Medical Practice are available to testify on this significant bill.
- 3. The Board discussed the issue of psychologists prescribing in 2021, when the Office of Professional Regulation was soliciting input from interested parties. The Board passed a motion expressing opposition to expanding the scope of practice of psychologists to allow prescribing. The motion passed on a 14-0 vote, with one member abstaining. The Board submitted written materials, which are submitted along with this memorandum. We ask you to carefully consider the points raised in those materials before making a decision on H.237.
