8	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to prohibit
9	health insurance plans and Vermont Medicaid from requiring a clinician's
10	referral or a signed care plan in order to provide coverage of or reimbursement
11	for physical therapy services. The bill would prohibit a health insurance plan
12	from imposing a co-payment or coinsurance requirement on a covered
13	individual for services provided by a physical therapist or physical therapist
14	assistant that exceeds the co-payment or coinsurance requirement that would
15	apply if the covered individual received services from a primary care provider
16	for the same or a similar health condition. The bill would also increase
17	Medicaid reimbursement rates for physical therapy services by 10 percent over
18	the course of two years.
