6	First: In Sec. 1, 8 V.S.A. § 4062, by striking out subdivision (c)(3)(A) in its
7	entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subdivision (c)(3)(A) to read as
8	follows:
9	(3)(A) In addition to the public comment provisions set forth in this
10	subsection (c), the Office of the Health Care Advocate established in 18 V.S.A
11	chapter 229, acting on behalf of health insurance consumers in this State, may,
12	within 30 calendar days after the Board receives an insurer's rate request
13	pursuant to this section, submit to the Board, in writing, suggested questions
14	regarding with an articulable nexus to the filing for that the Board to provide to
15	shall ask the insurer, either directly or through its contracting actuary, if any.
16	Second: In Sec. 3, 18 V.S.A. chapter 229, in section 9604, by striking out
17	subdivision (b)(1) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subdivision
18	(b)(1) to read as follows:
19	(1) When appropriate, State agencies shall allow the Office to access

confidential or proprietary information that is otherwise exempt from public

inspection and copying under the Public Records Act and to participate in

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1	meetings, deliberations, and proceedings in which confidential or proprietary
2	information is discussed; provided, however, that nothing in this section shall
3	require a State agency to provide or disclose information that is prohibited
4	from disclosure by State or federal law or that would cause the provider or
5	discloser to violate any statutory or common law privilege.
