

Chair Black and Members of the Committee,

As requested by the committee, below are measurements of outcomes related to our value based care initiatives, including case management, in comparison to members who are not engaged in those initiatives. There is clear evidence that value based care and case management initiatives lower cost of care.

## NEW STUDY – CASE MANAGEMENT RESULTS

### FULLY ENGAGED VS NON-ENGAGED MEMBERS FOR THE BOOK OF BUSINESS

- Results from comparison of members who were fully engaged with Integrated Health programs compared to members identified in the same time frame who did not engage.



#### Total PMPM Costs

Fully engaged members had 36% lower costs one year post-engagement.

Declined or unreachable members had 21% lower costs one year post-engagement.

Engaged members had a 15% greater reduction than non-managed members.



#### Inpatient PMPM Costs

Fully engaged members had 65% lower costs one year post-engagement.

Declined or unreachable members had 5% lower costs one year post-engagement.

Engaged members had a 60% greater reduction than non-managed members.



#### Potentially Avoidable ER

Fully engaged members had a potentially avoidable ER rate of 35%.

Declined or unreachable members had a potentially avoidable ER rate of 42%.

The rate for engaged members was 7% less than non-managed members.
