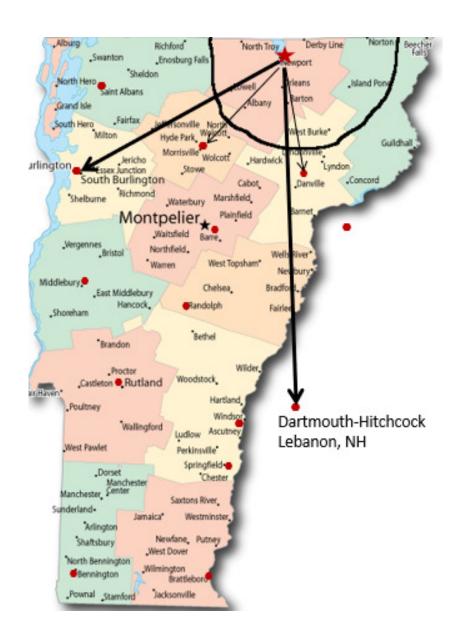

Working with Rural Health Redesign Center thru AHS to continue to work on ACT 167 and move forward with NCH Strategic Plan

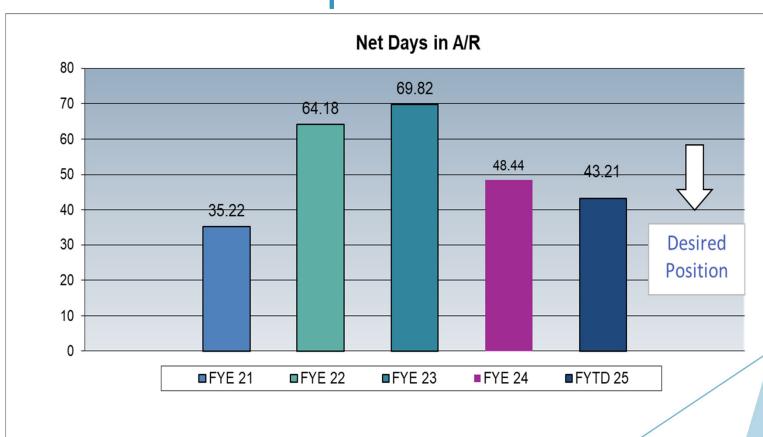
