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Introduction

What is "shopping" and how can it be helpful?

Medical services that are non-emergent and schedulable are considered **shoppable** because patients can research and choose where and when they want to receive those services.

Examples: imaging (MRIs), colonoscopies, laboratory services, cosmetic surgeries

When information about price and quality is available and readable, the hope is that patients and referring providers will make informed choices that **promote price competition** between healthcare sites **without compromising quality.**

89% of consumers willing to shop for care for at least one healthcare service

of consumers likely to see a different provider in return for \$100 incentive

Federal Efforts to Improve Price Transparency

2019 Executive Order on Improving Price & Quality Transparency: hospitals post negotiated prices for all services as MRFs, offer consumer-friendly shoppable service price navigation; establishes Health Quality Roadmap

2022 & 2023 CMS mandates: all insurers publish machine-readable files, insurers must provide members with online tool to estimate and compare costs

of U.S. hospitals were compliant with the federal transparency rule (despite daily fines)



Does not require personal information, breaks down charges more clearly than others No uniformity between price transparency tools means limited ability for people to compare costs!

New Hampshire Health Cost, "Time Spent in the Emergency Department Before Being Discharged"


Our Recommendations

1. Standardized Data Submissions from Vermont Hospitals

- The State should **work collaboratively with hospitals** to establish a standardized, consumer-friendly format that all hospitals will use to publish reliable, accurate, and complete pricing information for shoppable services;
- The State should **work with VPQHC** to identify meaningful hospital quality metrics that each hospital should be required to post alongside their standardized consumer pricing tool;
- The **GMCB** should ensure compliance in the hospital budget review process; consider state fines for non-compliance.

3. Campaigns and Incentives to Promote Use of Tools

Transparency tools will not be useful if patients don't know they exist!

- NH Health Cost SmartShopper provides rebates for use of transparency tools.
- **Right-to-shop** laws require insurers to share savings with patients who choose cheaper options.
 - Savings amount = half of the difference in the cost between the chosen option and the average cost in the area
