What is the Youth Development Program (YDP)?

- Our Work: YDP is Vermont's extended care program for teens and young adults who have experience with the foster care system.
- Our Mission: To ensure that youth with foster care experience enter adulthood with the necessary support to build productive and fulfilling lives. By investing in youth, YDP promotes healthier and better- connected young adults, families, and communities.
- Our Philosophy: We believe in providing services that are strength-based and fully driven by the youths' own identified goals. YDP is a voluntary program.



Who We Serve

- Youth ages 14-23 who are currently in custody or exited at 16 or older are eligible for case management, funding and advocacy opportunities
- Youth may connect with YDP any time before they turn 23.

YDP serves about 450 youth statewide annually!













Our Services

- Youth Development Coordinators (YDCs) are case managers who partner with youth to help them set goals, explore personal interests, connect with natural supports, and transition to adulthood successfully.
- Financial resources provide flexible funding through Youth Investment Grants (YIGs) to support interests and goals of youth who are engaged in the program.
- Extended foster care financially supports former foster parents and other supportive adults to care for youth beyond the age of 18.
- Leadership opportunities empower and inspire youth to advocate for improvements in the child welfare system and beyond.




