2 Representative McGill of Bridport moves that the House propose to the  
3 Senate that the report of the Committee on Human Services be amended as  
4 follows:

5 First: By striking out Sec. 6, reports; public inebriate services and  
6 programming, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Sec. 6 to read  
7 as follows:

8 Sec. 6. REPORTS; SERVICES AND PROGRAMMING **FOR PERSONS**  
9 **WHO ARE INCAPACITATED**

10 (a)(1) The Departments of Health and of Mental Health's existing plan to  
11 expand services and programming **for persons who are incapacitated pursuant**  
12 **to 18 V.S.A. § 4810** shall prioritize Chittenden County.

13 (2) On or before February 15, 2026, the Departments of Health and of  
14 Mental Health shall jointly provide a presentation to the House Committees on  
15 Health Care and on Human Services and to the Senate Committee on Health  
16 and Welfare describing efforts to expand services and programming **for**  
17 **persons who are incapacitated** pursuant to subdivision (1) of this subsection.

18 (b) On or before February 15, 2026, the Department of Corrections shall  
19 provide a presentation to the House Committees on **Corrections and**  
20 **Institutions, on** Health Care, and on Human Services and to the Senate  
21 **Committees on Institutions and on** Health and Welfare describing efforts to

1 reinstate the practice of connecting persons who are in a correctional facility  
2 due to incapacitation pursuant to 18 V.S.A. § 4810 with appropriate  
3 community-based substance use recovery providers.

4 Second: By proposing to the Senate to amend the bill i n Sec. 4, repeal, by  
5 striking out “public inebriates” and inserting in lieu thereof “persons who are  
6 incapacitated”

7 and that after passage the title of the bill be amended to read: “An act  
8 relating to the delivery and payment of certain services provided through the  
9 Agency of Human Services, services for persons who are incapacitated, and  
10 Human Services Board proceedings”
