- VT 211's database contains more than 1100 agencies and 3100 programs
- VT 211 is a *nationally accredited* Information & Referral service with *certified* Resource Specialists and Database Curators
- 211 is part of the federally designated N-11 system
- VT 211 partners with the State of Vermont to support General Assistance Emergency Housing
- VT 211 is a key partner in the State Emergency Operations Center, collecting damage reports from the public, and providing information & rumor control

It's more than just a referral. 211 is a **neutral entry point** to get connected to help. Our Community Resource Specialists:

- Establish rapport
- Gather information through active listening
- Determine the caller's previous efforts
- Problem solve in partnership with the caller
- Match resources with needs
- Identify potential barriers
- Make appropriate referrals to services
- Offer follow-up if appropriate
