 respectfully reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the

 bill be amended by striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in

 lieu thereof the following:
- 7 Sec. 1. 13 V.S.A. § 1455 is amended to read:
- 8 § 1455. HATE-MOTIVATED CRIMES
 - (a) A person who commits, causes to be committed, or attempts to commit any crime and whose conduct is motivated, in whole or in part, by the victim's another person's or a group of persons' actual or perceived membership in a protected category shall be subject to the following penalties:
 - (1) If the maximum penalty for the underlying crime is one year or less, the penalty for a violation of this section shall be imprisonment for not more than two years or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.
 - (2) If the maximum penalty for the underlying crime is more than one year but less than five years, the penalty for a violation of this section shall be imprisonment for not more than five years or a fine of not more than \$10,000.00, or both.

1	(3) If the maximum penalty for the underlying crime is five years or		
2	more, the penalty for the underlying crime shall apply; however, the court shall		
3	consider the motivation of the defendant as a factor in sentencing.		
4	(b) The victim's A person's or a group of persons' actual or perceived		
5	membership in a protected category or categories need not be the predominant		
6	reason or the sole reason for the defendant's conduct.		
7	(c) As used in this section, "protected category" includes race, color,		
8	religion, national origin, sex, ancestry, age, service in the U.S. Armed Forces		
9	or the National Guard, disability as defined by 21 V.S.A. § 495d(5), sexual		
10	orientation, gender identity, and perceived membership in any such group.
