12	reasonable attorney's fees. A writ of possession shall issue on the date	
13	judgment is entered, unless the court for good cause orders a stay. The writ	
14	shall direct the any sheriff of the county in which the property or a portion	
15	thereof is located to serve the writ upon the defendant and, not earlier than 14	
16	days after the writ is served, to put the plaintiff into possession.
