Good Evening Nate,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide DPS input into draft 2.2 of S.208. In lieu of testimony tomorrow, please accept this written testimony in response to the changes.

DPS believes that regulation around identification and masks is best addressed as a statewide model policy under the Law Enforcement Advisory Board (LEAB).

Alternatively, DPS provides the following responses to the changes in draft 2.2:

- § 2373(C)(2): This provision does not allow for circumstances in which an officer approaches someone and introduces themselves in advance of an arrest or detention. We offer the following addition to this provision: (2) A law enforcement officer shall verbally disclose, in a clear and audible manner, the officer's name and the official name of the officer's agency upon initial contact, when detaining, or arresting an individual as soon as it is practical and safe to do so.
- § 2373(C)(3)(A): Please add "...investigate criminal activity or civil violations under state statute..." to provide for situations in which Liquor Control and Fish and Wildlife investigate civil violations under state statute.
