The AOT Hearings Examiners hold administrative hearings relating to highway and motor vehicle laws for the Agency of Transportation.

Hearings are held in accordance with the delegations of authority from the Secretary of Transportation and the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles.

Administrative hearings are requested by individuals who wish to appeal a decision made by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) or the Agency of Transportation. The entire hearing process is managed by the Hearing Examiner, from accepting the request through the issuance of a decision.

- 301 hearings requested to review DMV actions in CY24.
- 256 of those requests were approved for hearing, 147 cases were resolved without a hearing, and 109 went to a written decision.
