

1 (2) In evaluating applications for Transportation Alternatives grants, the
2 Agency shall give preferential weighting to projects involving as a primary
3 feature a bicycle or pedestrian facility. The degree of preferential weighting
4 and the circumstantial factors sufficient to overcome the weighting shall be in
5 the complete discretion of the Agency.

6 (g) The Agency shall develop an outreach and marketing effort designed to
7 provide information to communities with respect to the benefits of
8 participating in the Transportation Alternatives Grant Program. The outreach
9 and marketing activities shall include apprising municipalities of the
10 availability of grants for salt and sand sheds. The outreach effort should be
11 directed to areas of the State historically underserved by this Program.
