12 licensing an operator of motor vehicles or for issuing an operator's privilege  
13 card shall be \$124.00.

14 (2) The four-year fee required to be paid the Commissioner for licensing  
15 an operator of motor vehicles or for issuing an operator's privilege card shall  
16 be \$62.00.

17 (3) The two-year fee required to be paid the Commissioner for licensing  
18 an operator or for issuing an operator's privilege card shall be \$39.00, and the  
19 two-year fee for licensing a junior operator or for issuing a junior operator's  
20 privilege card shall be \$39.00.

2       § 115. NONDRIVER IDENTIFICATION CARDS

3           (a)(1) Any Vermont resident may make application to the Commissioner  
4       and be issued an identification card that is attested by the Commissioner as to  
5       true name, correct age, residential address unless the listing of another address  
6       is requested by the applicant or is otherwise authorized by law, and any other  
7       identifying data ~~as the Commissioner may require that shall include, in~~  
8       required by the Commissioner. In the case of minor applicants, the  
9       Commissioner shall require the written consent of the applicant's parent,  
10      guardian, or other person standing in loco parentis.

11          (2) Every application for an identification card shall be signed by the  
12      applicant and shall contain such evidence of age and identity as the  
13      Commissioner may require, consistent with subsection (1) of this section.

14          (3) New and renewal application forms shall include a space for the  
15      applicant to request that a "veteran" designation be placed on the applicant's  
16      identification card. If a veteran, as defined in 38 U.S.C. § 101(2) and including  
17      an individual disabled during active military, naval, air, or space service, as  
18      defined in 38 U.S.C. § 101(24), requests a veteran designation and provides a  
19      Department of Defense Form 214 or other proof of veteran status specified by  
20      the Commissioner, and the Office of Veterans' Affairs confirms the veteran's  
21      status as an honorably discharged veteran; a veteran discharged under

1 honorable conditions; or an individual disabled during active military, naval,  
2 air, or space service, the identification card shall include the term “veteran” on  
3 its face.

4 (4) The Commissioner shall require payment of a fee of \$29.00 for a  
5 four-year nondriver identification card or \$58.00 for an eight-year nondriver  
6 identification card at the time application for an identification card is made,  
7 except that an initial nondriver identification card shall be issued at no charge  
8 to an individual who surrenders the individual’s license in connection with a  
9 suspension or revocation under subsection 636(b) of this title due to a physical  
10 or mental condition.

11 (b)(1) Every identification card shall expire, unless earlier canceled, at  
12 12:00 midnight on the eve of the fourth or eighth anniversary of the date of  
13 birth of the cardholder following the date of original issue and may be renewed  
14 four years upon payment of a \$29.00 fee or for eight years upon payment of a  
15 \$58.00 fee.

16 (2) A renewed identification card shall expire, unless earlier canceled, at  
17 12:00 midnight on the eve of the fourth or eighth anniversary of the date of  
18 birth of the cardholder following the expiration of the card being renewed.

19 (3) At least 30 days before an identification card will expire, the  
20 Commissioner shall mail first-class to the cardholder or send the cardholder  
21 electronically an application to renew the identification card; ~~a.~~ A cardholder

1 shall be sent the renewal notice by mail unless the cardholder opts in to receive  
2 electronic notification.
