37 card shall be \$62.00.

38 (3) The two-year fee required to be paid the Commissioner for
39 licensing an operator or for issuing an operator's privilege card shall be

44 § 115. NONDRIVER IDENTIFICATION CARDS

45 (a)(1) Any Vermont resident may make application to the Commissioner
46 and be issued an identification card that is attested by the Commissioner as to
47 true name, correct age, residential address unless the listing of another address
48 is requested by the applicant or is otherwise authorized by law, and any other
49 identifying data ~~as the Commissioner may require that shall include, in~~
50 required by the Commissioner. In the case of minor applicants, the
51 Commissioner shall require the written consent of the applicant's parent,
52 guardian, or other person standing in loco parentis.

53 (2) Every application for an identification card shall be signed by
54 the applicant and shall contain such evidence of age and identity as the
55 Commissioner may require, consistent with subsection (1) of this section.

56 (3) New and renewal application forms shall include a space for the
57 applicant to request that a "veteran" designation be placed on the applicant's
58 identification card. If a veteran, as defined in 38 U.S.C. § 101(2) and
59 including an individual disabled during active military, naval, air, or space

60 service, as defined in 38 U.S.C. § 101(24), requests a veteran designation and
61 provides a Department of Defense Form 214 or other proof of veteran status
62 specified by the Commissioner, and the Office of Veterans' Affairs confirms
63 the veteran's status as an honorably discharged veteran; a veteran discharged
64 under honorable conditions; or an individual disabled during active military,
65 naval, air, or space service, the identification card shall include the term
66 "veteran" on its face.

67 (4) The Commissioner shall require payment of a fee of \$29.00 for
68 a four-year nondriver identification card or \$58.00 for an eight-year nondriver
69 identification card at the time application for an identification card is made,
70 except that an initial nondriver identification card shall be issued at no charge
71 to an individual who surrenders the individual's license in connection with a
72 suspension or revocation under subsection 636(b) of this title due to a physical
73 or mental condition.

74 (b)(1) Every identification card shall expire, unless earlier canceled, at
75 12:00 midnight on the eve of the fourth or eighth anniversary of the date of
76 birth of the cardholder following the date of original issue and may be renewed
77 four years upon payment of a \$29.00 fee or for eight years upon payment of a
78 \$58.00 fee.

79 (2) A renewed identification card shall expire, unless earlier
80 canceled, at 12:00 midnight on the eve of the fourth or eighth anniversary of
81 the date of birth of the cardholder following the expiration of the card being
82 renewed.

83 (3) At least 30 days before an identification card will expire, the
84 Commissioner shall mail first-class to the cardholder or send the cardholder
85 electronically an application to renew the identification card; ~~a.~~ A cardholder

1 shall be sent the renewal notice by mail unless the cardholder opts in to receive 2
electronic notification.
