


Vermont DMV Commercial Vehicle Enforcement 2025 Overview



Vermont DMV Commercial Vehicle Enforcement section

- Comprised of 22 Sworn Inspectors, and 2 civilian Inspectors.
- Broken into 3 sectors of responsibility-Northwest, South and Northeast.
- Traffic Enforcement team, focused on Crash reduction in identified high crash corridors.
- In 2025 VTDMV generated 15,656 incidents.

Distribution of duties

Roadside Inspections: 9,838 (62.84%)

Traffic Stops (Passenger Cars): 1,327 (8.48%)

Agency Assist: 690 (4.41%)

Commercial Vehicle Safety Inspection Details: 482 (3.08%)

Commercial Vehicle Directed Patrols: 432 (2.76%)

Safety Audits: 148 (0.95%)

Post-Crash CMV Inspections: 134 (0.86%)

Car Seat Inspections: 84 (0.54%)

Industry Outreach Events: 67 (0.43%)

Motorist Assist: 54 (0.35%)

Motor Vehicle Complaints: 42 (0.27%)

Compliance Reviews: 24 (0.15%)

Traffic Hazards: 22 (0.14%)

DRE Activations: 21 (0.13%)

Other Incidents: 2,251 (14.38%)



Crashes

There were a total of 442 crashes involving commercial motor vehicles in Vermont in 2025.

157 of those were reportable crashes. Including 57 injuries to occupants and 4 fatalities.

285 did not rise to the level of being reportable.

134 Post crash inspections were completed by Motor Vehicle Inspectors

Inspectors also responded to 14 noncommercial vehicle reportable crashes.



Projects

Vermont DMV Enforcement and safety completed two Smart roadside enforcement locations that will provide the Agency of Transportation weigh in motion data 24 hours a day.

The systems are an enforcement tool that can identify.

- Weight
- Tire anomalies
- USDOT numbers

All of these items help VTDMV to focus on the trucks and companies that need to be contacted at roadside for the purpose of roadside safety inspections



Projects continued

VTDMV purchased three speed carts that are placed in high crash areas to influence driver behavior.

VTDMV also purchased Virtual message boards that are controlled by the Traffic management center and can be used to relay information to Vermont traffic.

VTDMV teamed with the University of Massachusetts who conducts detailed studies and provides crash maps that outline high crash corridors. This information is combined with information collected by the Agency of transportation to provide an overall picture of our high crash corridors, times all with other metrics to enhance our patrol practices.



Enforcement action

Inspectors issued approximately 4,350 tickets and warnings in 2025.

-777 tickets

-2,512 warnings

-1,690 tickets/warnings were issued to commercial motor vehicle drivers or companies.

Inspectors made 44 arrests for criminal infractions.



Size & Weight Enforcement

- Inspectors conducted 455 portable weighs
- 8,860 platform weighs
- 818,895 Weigh in motion (WIM)
- Issued 215 citations for S&W violations
- Force off loaded 10 vehicles.

DMV issued the following permits:

- 8,541 Single Trip (non divisible)
- 2,037 Blanket permit (annual non divisible)
- 8,378 Divisible overweight.
