

# **GO! VERMONT TRIP PLANNER**

Cost: \$10,000 to start up & \$60,000 for ongoing maintenance.

Free trip planning that shows all available modes of travel (Bus, Vanpool, Carpool, Train, Ferry, Walk, or Bike).

From May 1, 2023 - April 30, 2024, Vermont had 109,305 recorded trips. In April 2024, there were 10,059 recorded trips.

Funding from FHWA Road and Bridge Funding (flexed funds).

#### CATMA BIKESHARE

- Serves Burlington, South Burlington, and Winooski.
- Founded in 2023.
- Revenue through an app-based payment collection (Bird). \$1 to unlock bike, 49 cents per minute for the duration of trip. 50% discount for low income riders. 20% discount for CATMA members.

## WALK TO SHOP

- Cost: \$50,000 to startup and \$100,000 in capital;
   \$100,000 for ongoing operations.
- Serves transit service areas, downtowns, and villages across Vermont.
- Revenue from the sale of trolleys covers a portion of the project costs.
- Funding from the State of Vermont, regional grants, corporate sponsorships, and cash and in-kind contributions from partners and volunteers.
- Resource for public education and community engagement, walking, 15 min-neighborhoods.
