

GO! VERMONT TRIP PLANNER

Cost: \$10,000 to start up & \$60,000 for ongoing maintenance.

Free trip planning that shows all available modes of travel (Bus, Vanpool, Carpool, Train, Ferry, Walk, or Bike).

From May 1, 2023 - April 30, 2024, Vermont had 109,305 recorded trips. In April 2024, there were 10,059 recorded trips.

Funding from FHWA Road and Bridge Funding (flexed funds).

GO! VERMONT CARPOOL MATCHING



- Cost: \$10,000 to start up & \$60,000 for ongoing maintenance.
- Free carpool matching for anyone who is a Go! Vermont member.
- From May 1, 2023 April 30, 2024, Vermont had 10,370 recorded carpool trips.
 In April 2024, there were 706 recorded carpool trips.
- Funding from FHWA Road and Bridge Funding.

VANPOOL / COMMUTE WITH ENTERPRISE



- Spends \$90,000 on ongoing operating costs.
- As of December 2024, Vermont had 22 operating vanpools.
- Go! Vermont provides a 75% subsidy for the first three months and then a 50% subsidy for each month after.
 - Funding through VTrans FTA 5311 Formula and State funding at a (50/50 share) to cover operation subsidy.
- Vanpool riders pay a fare to ride in the van. This fare covers the remaining operating costs after the Go! Vermont subsidy.
