Subject: Early credential renewal update

Beginning July 1, 2025, the Department of Motor Vehicles implemented process changes to allow Vermonters to renew their non-commercial driver's licenses and non-driver identification cards at any point ahead of their expiration date in accordance with Secs. 16-18 of Act 66 of 2025. In addition, with the launch of the final phase of the department's system modernization project, Vermonters are now able to renew credentials early online through myDMV.
