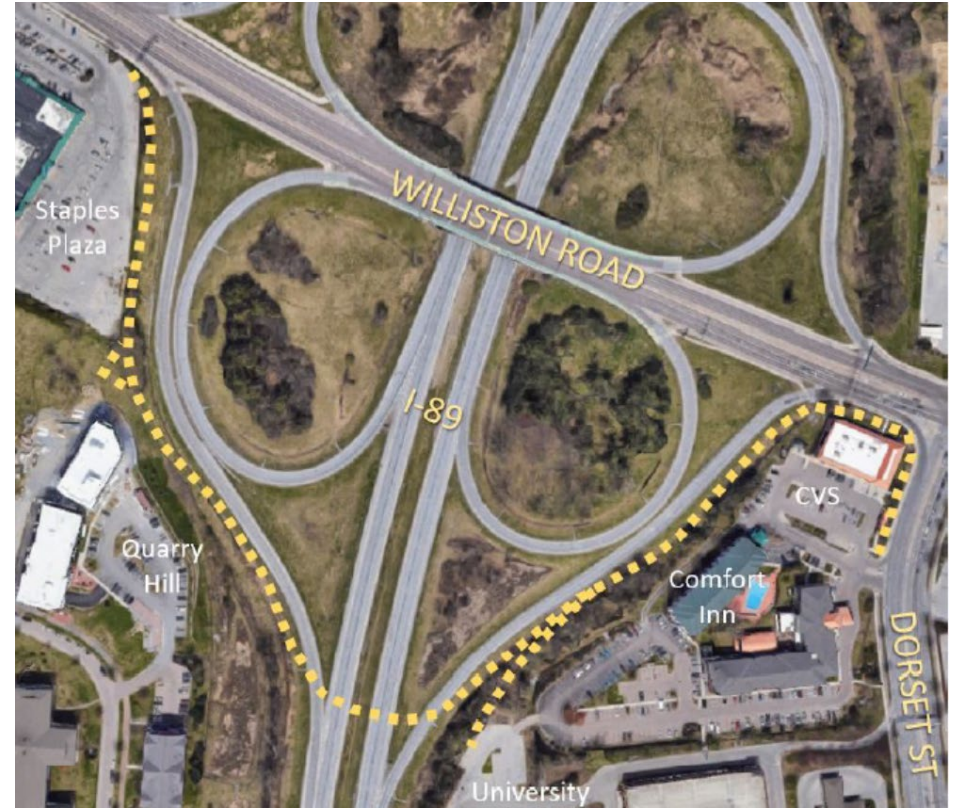

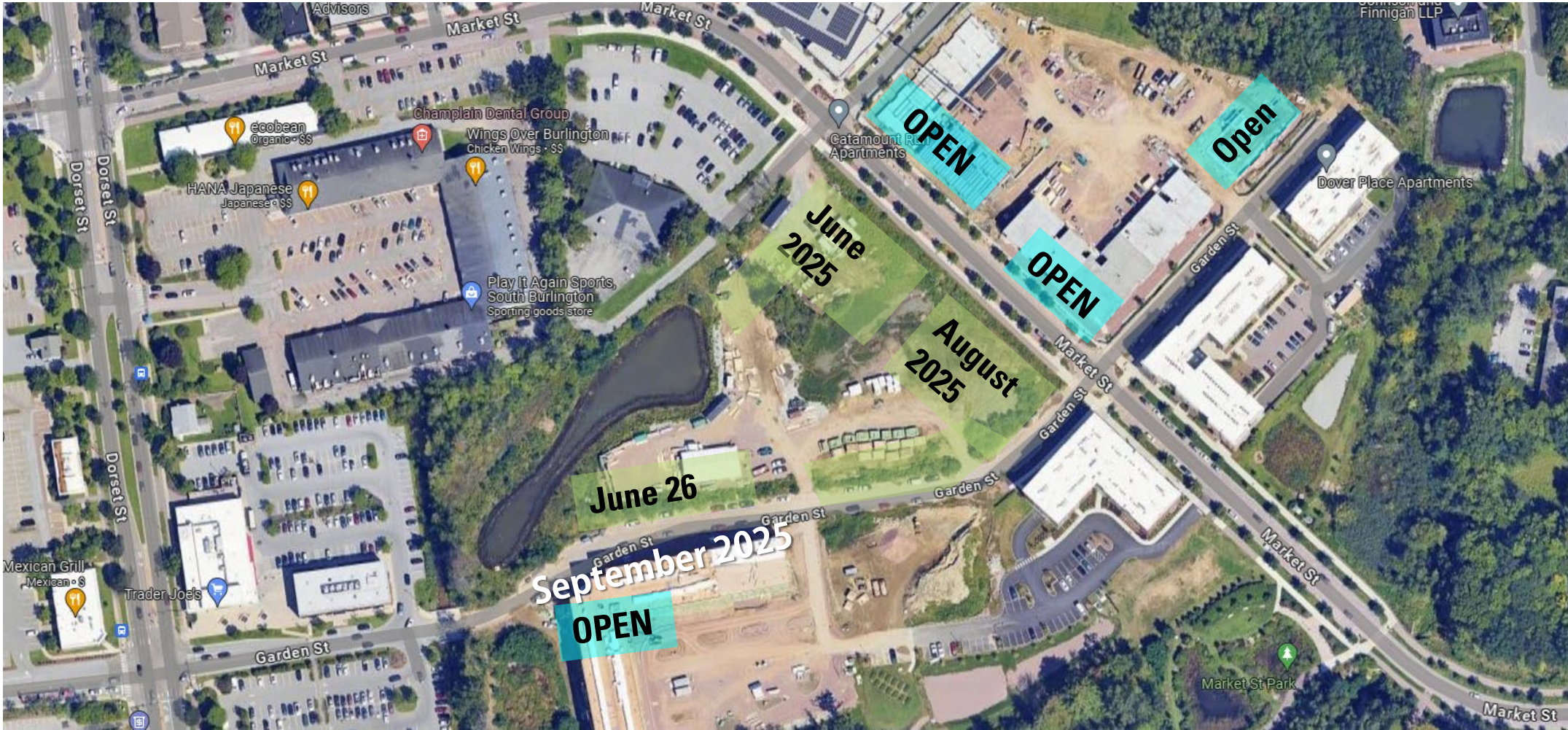
EAST-WEST CROSSING WALK BIKE BRIDGE OVER I-89

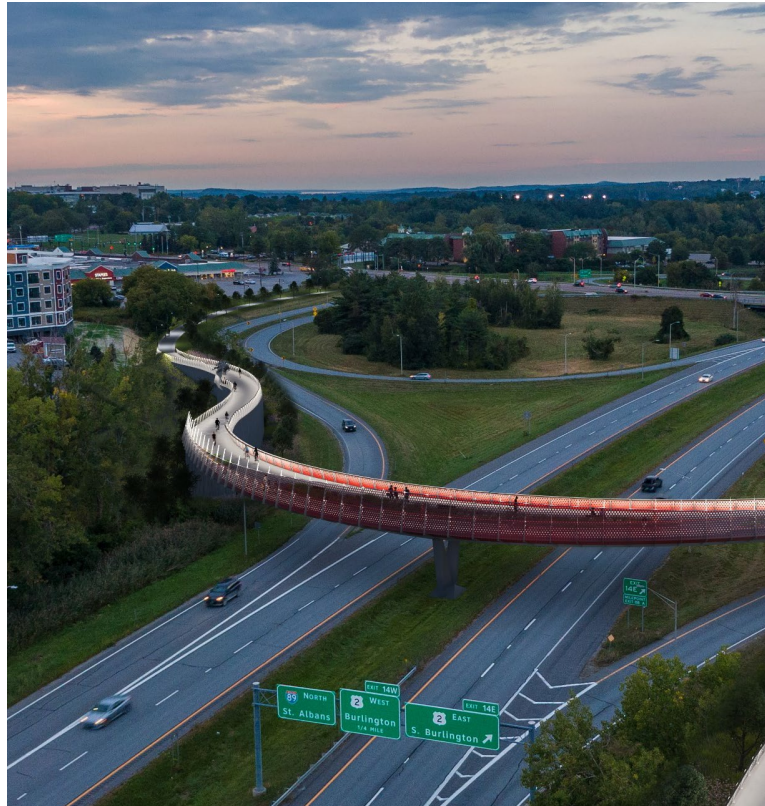

OUTCOMES

PROJECTED FROM GRANT APPLICATION

- Increase pedestrian and bicycle trips by 634 annually from an estimated 152 based on 2019 counts.
- 5% reduction in vehicular crashes for the interchange (average 54 per year, reporting will be per million vehicle miles traveled)

ACTUAL BASELINE DATA

MEASURED OCTOBER – DECEMBER 2024

- Pedestrian and bicycle daily usage
 - Weekday path average – 275
 - Weekend path average – 434
 - Weekday road average – 15
 - Weekend road average - 18
- 15 vehicular crashes occurred in the interchange or 6 per 1M VMT.

Timeline

- Bid project – this spring
- Construction completion – December 2026
