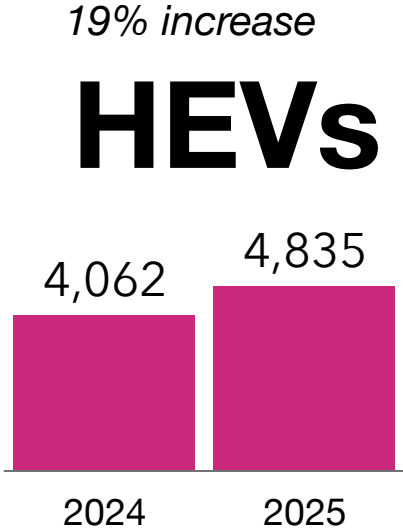

# NEW Vehicles Purchased and Registered in Vermont 2024 vs 2025

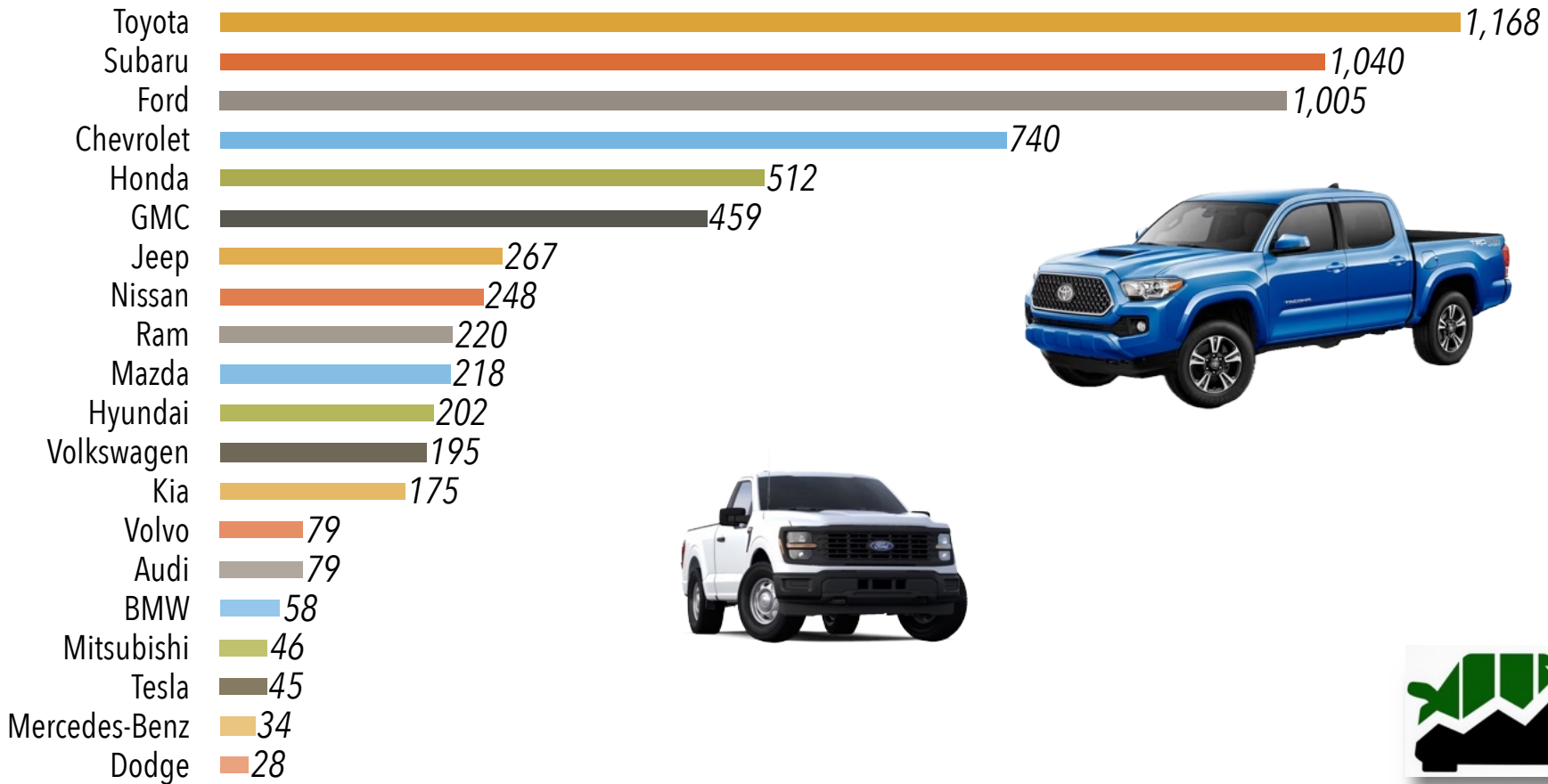

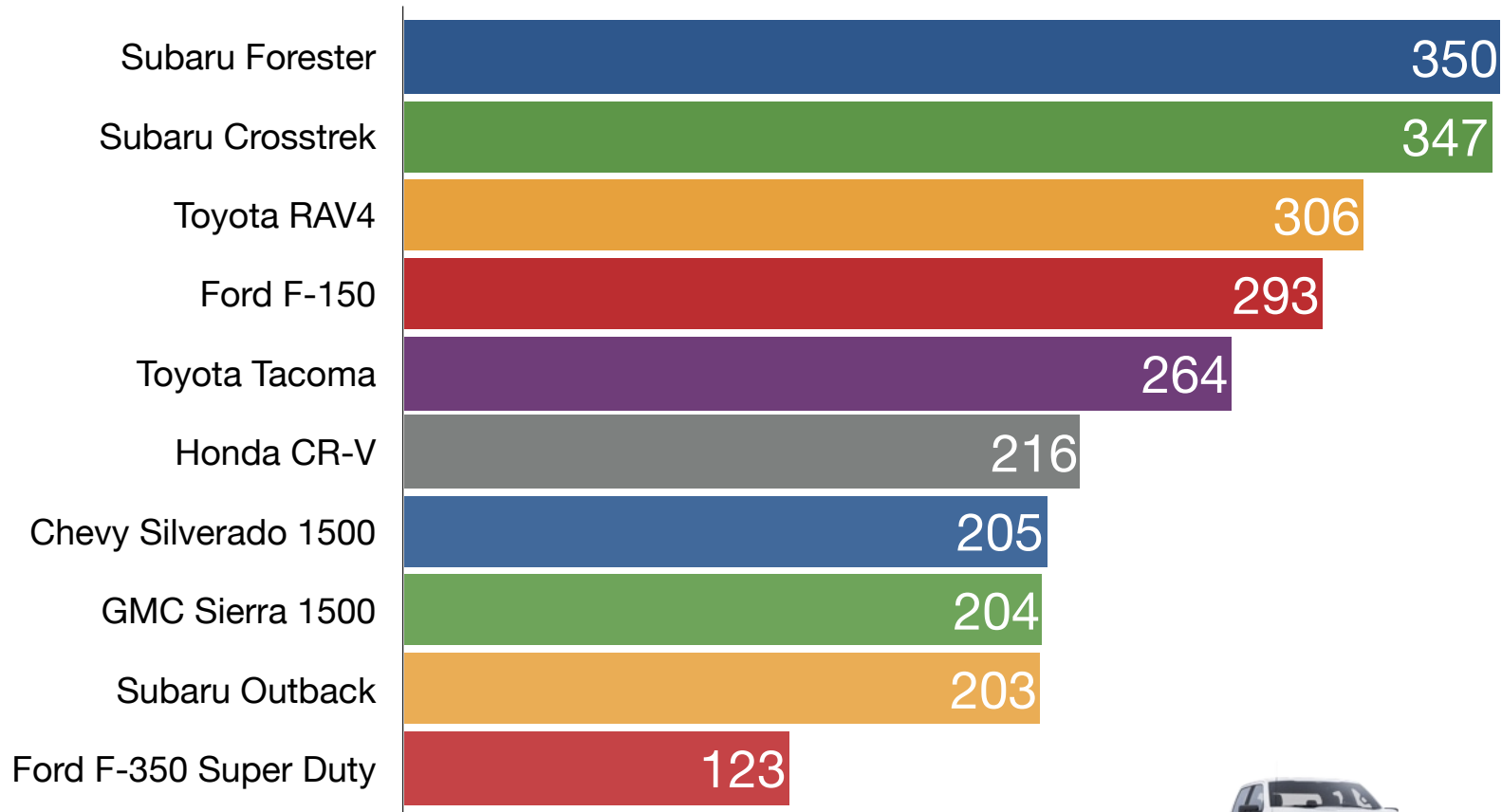
# The Top Twenty New Vehicles by Make

Registered in Vermont, January-March 2026



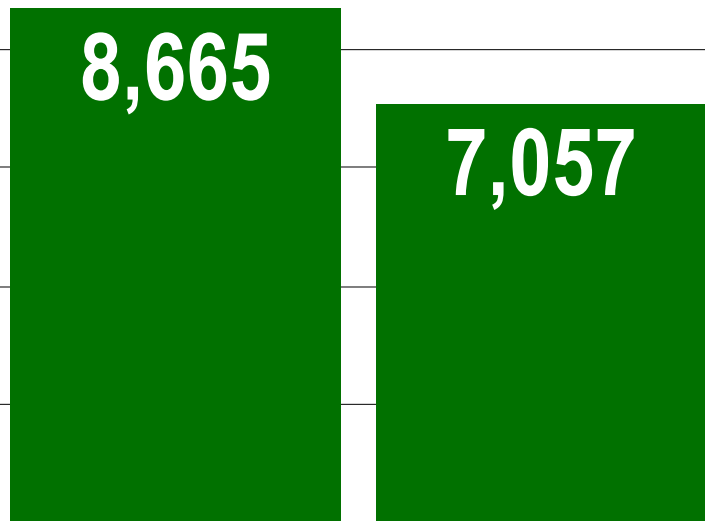
# The Top Ten New Vehicles by Model

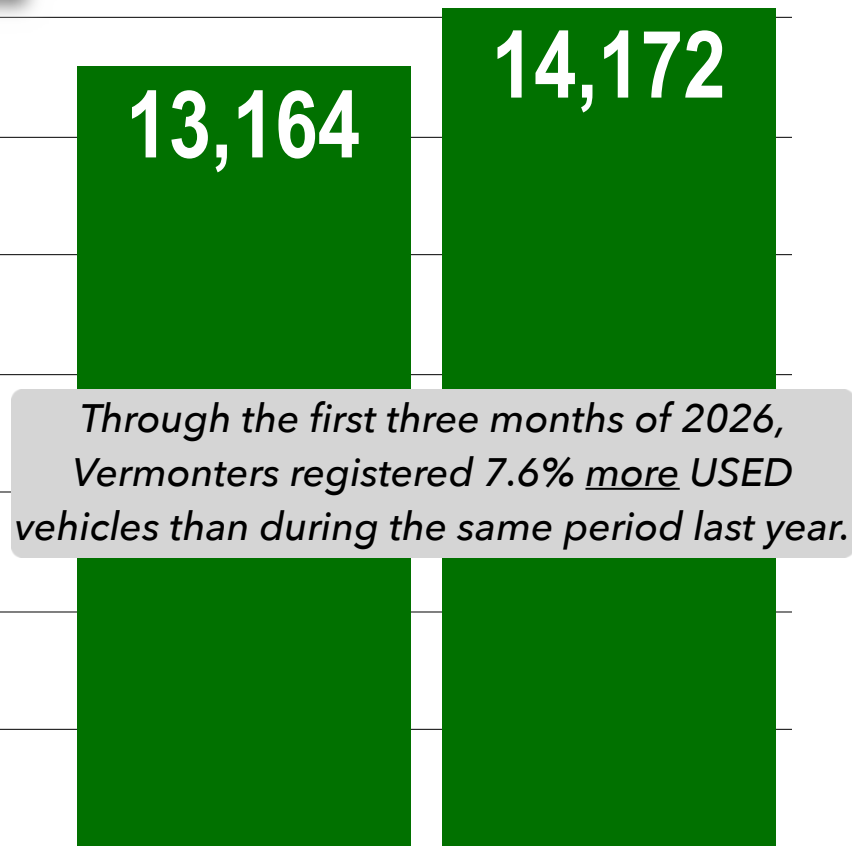




Through the first three months of 2026, Vermonters have registered 18.5% fewer new vehicles than during the same period last year.

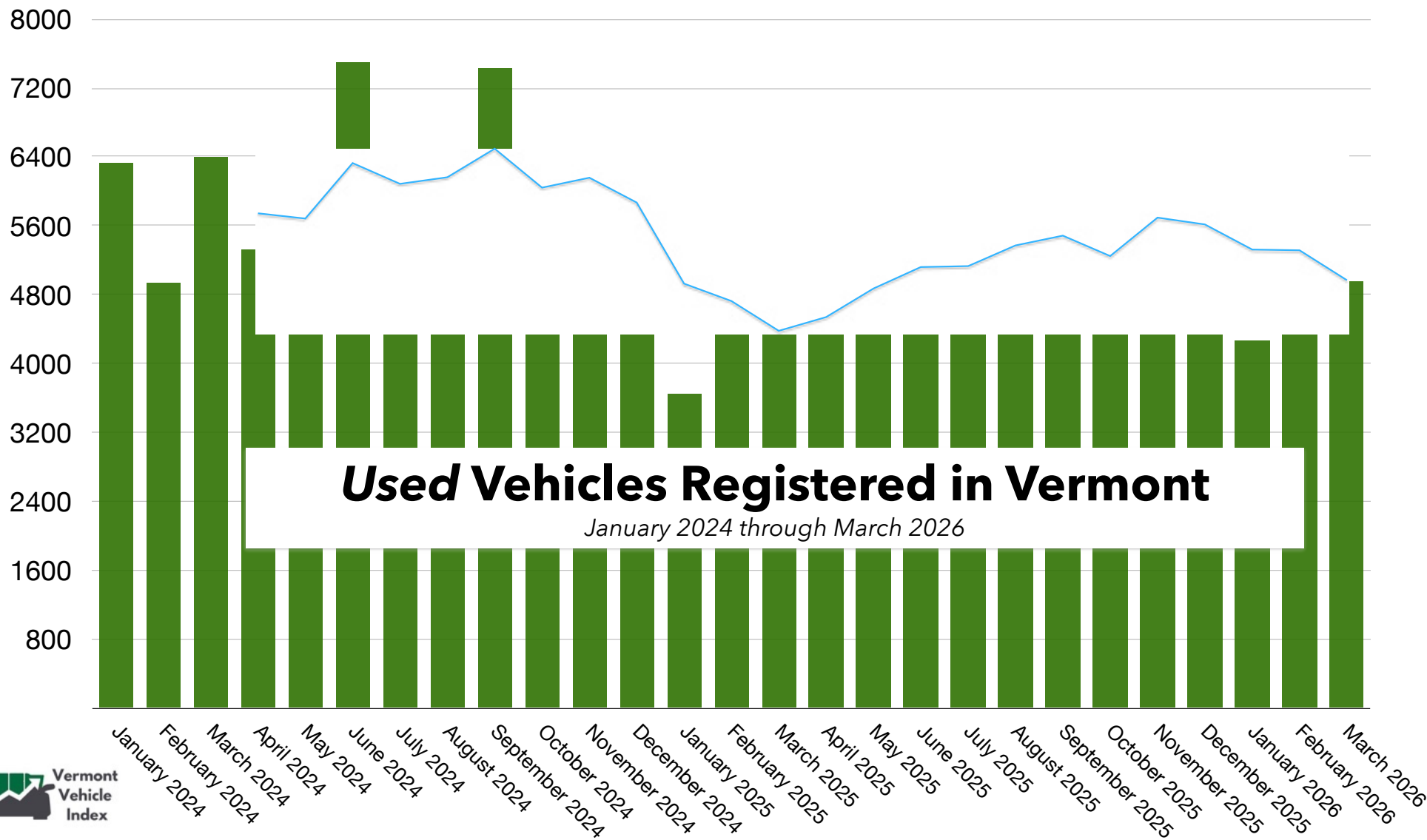

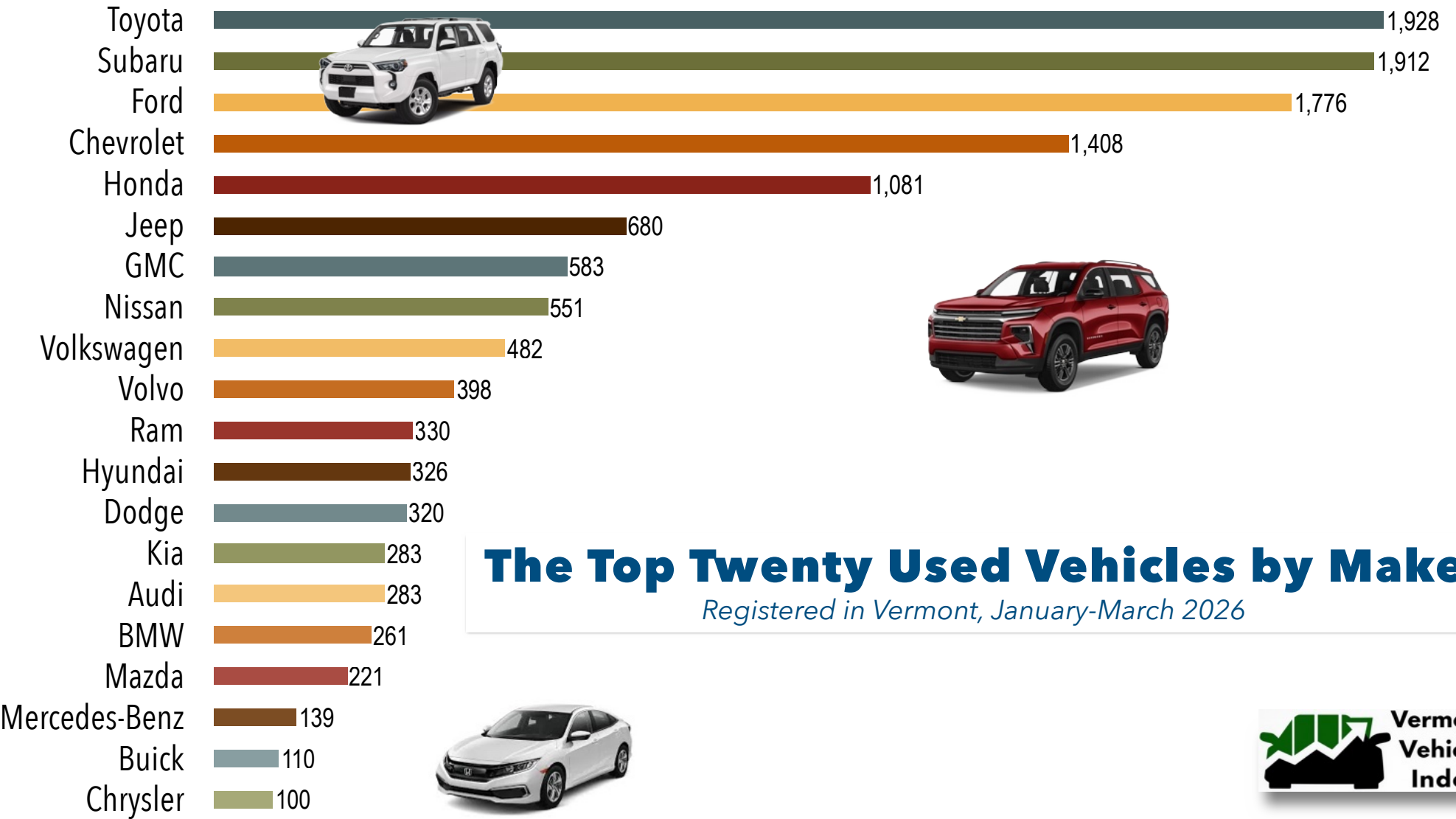


Through the first three months of 2026, Vermonters registered 7.6% more USED vehicles than during the same period last year.

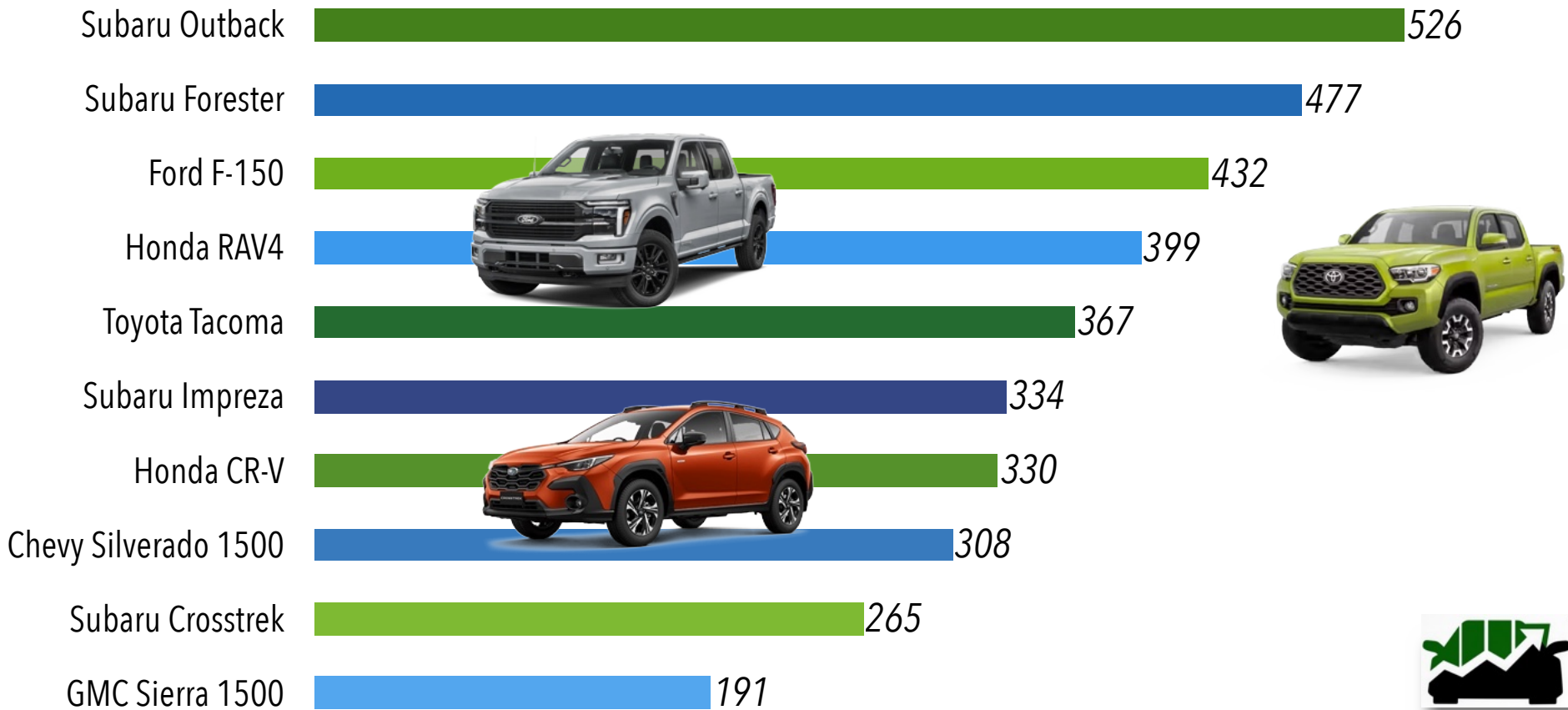

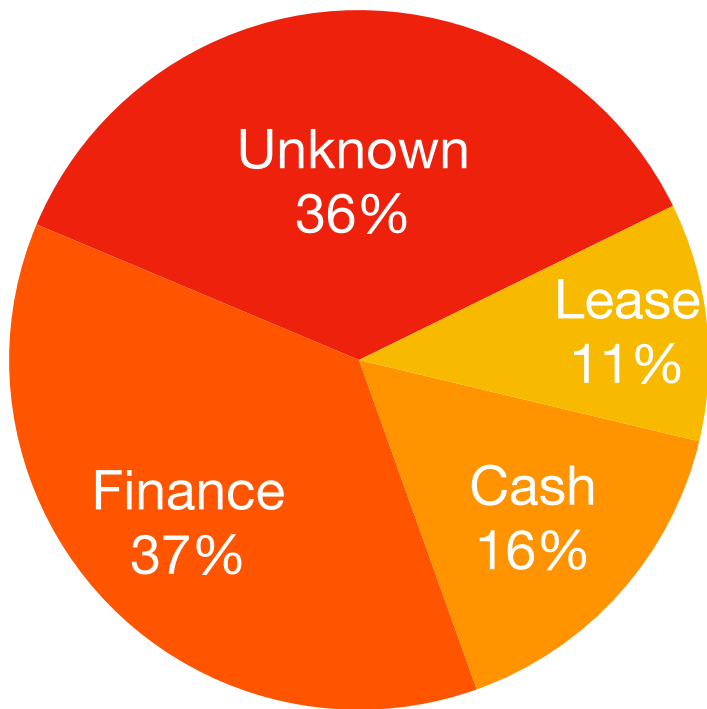

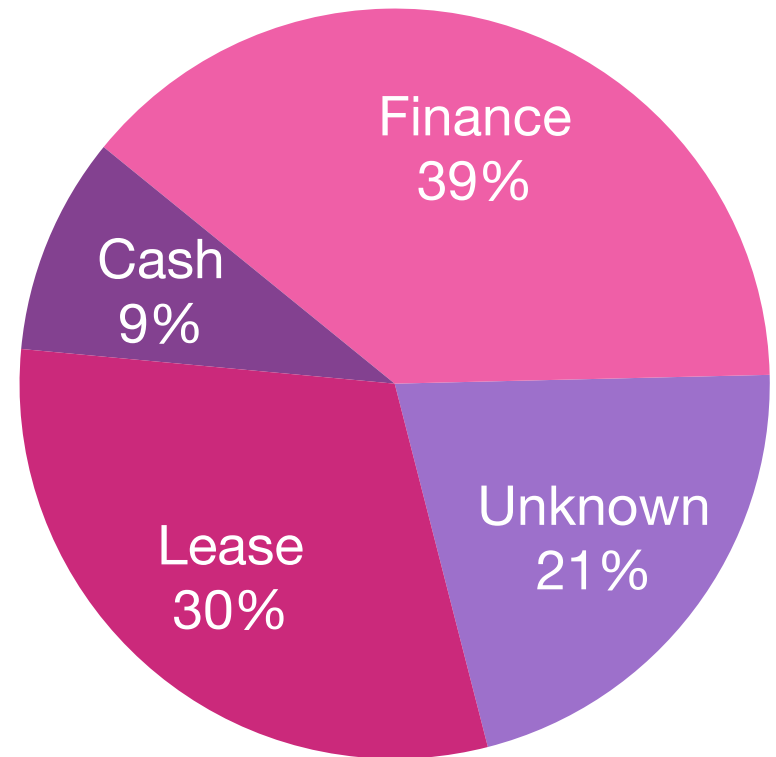

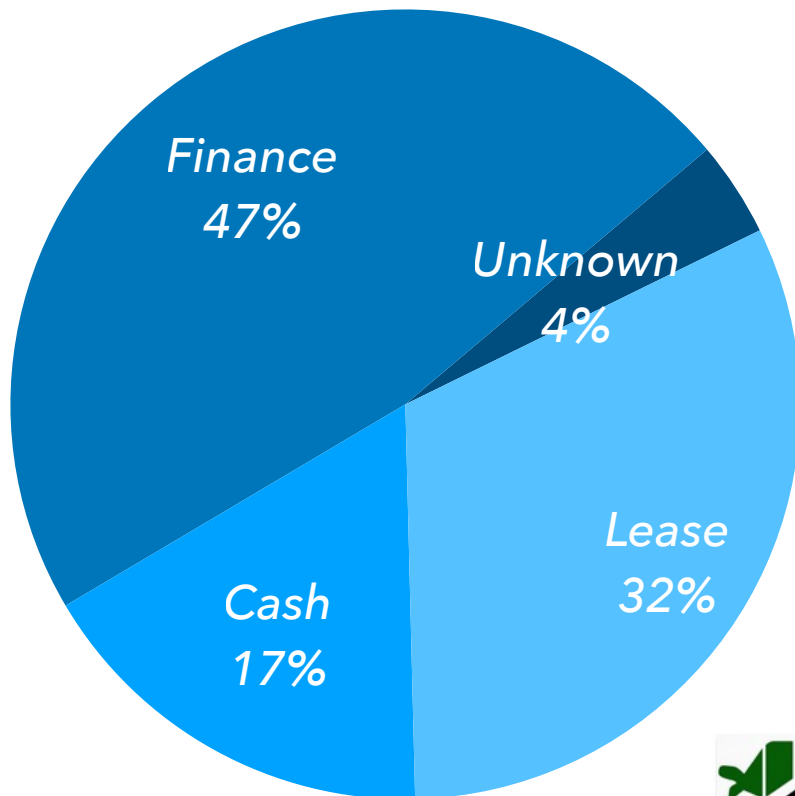

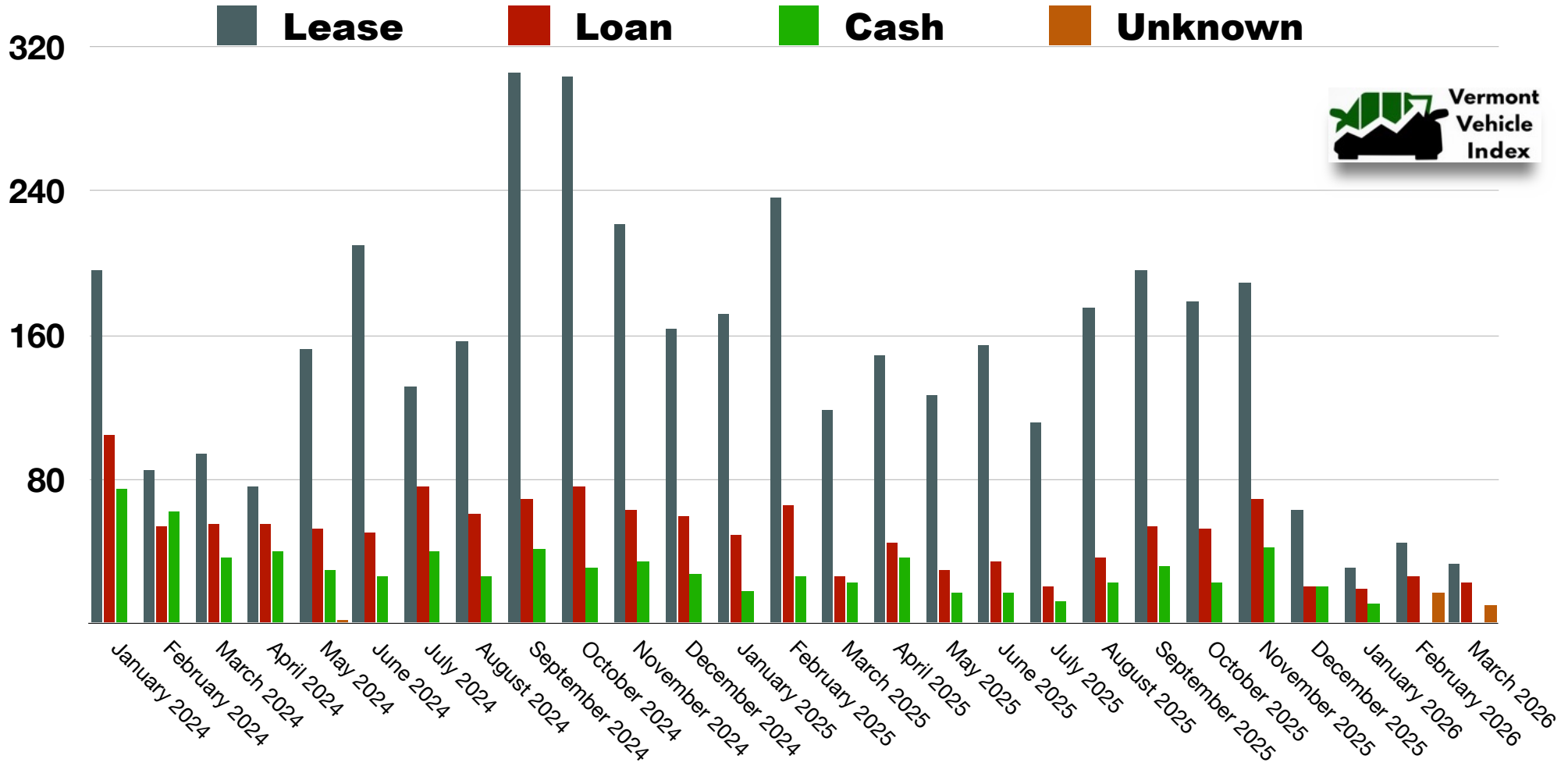

January 2024 through March 2026

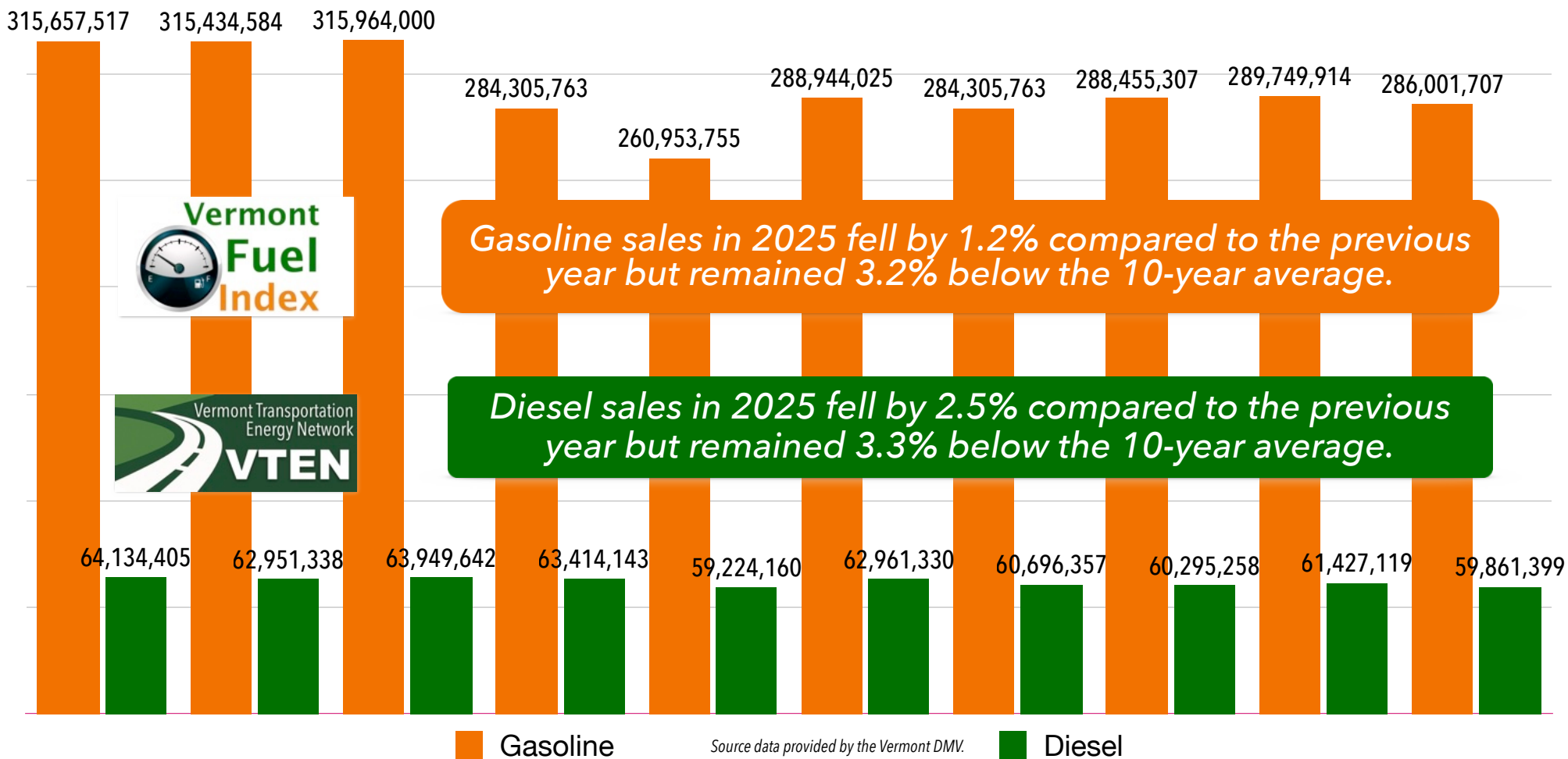




**As two- to three-year leases expire, EVs are expected to account for nearly 15% of off-lease used vehicles by year's end—up from 7.7% in the first quarter.**

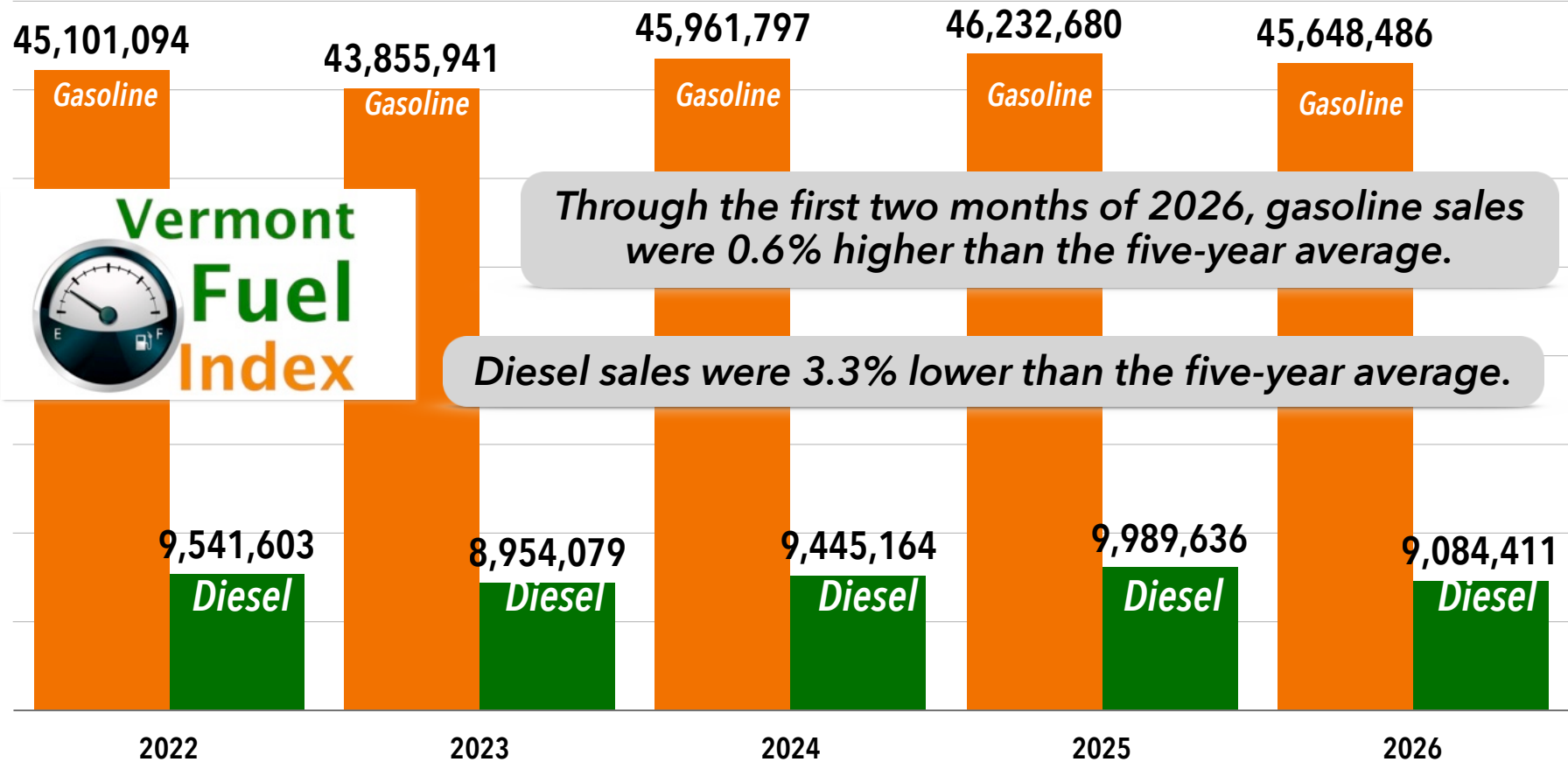


# Annual Sales of Gasoline and Diesel in Vermont, gallons
