SUBJECT: Proposed Adjustments to AGO Fees in H.493

The committee of conference report on H.493 (fiscal year 2026 appropriations act) contains several adjustments to fees administered by the Attorney General’s Office (AGO). These fees are expected to generate approximately **\$42,000** of additional revenue to the Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund (21780) and would support the AGO’s Fiscal Year 2026 budget.

**Paid fundraiser fees** (9 V.S.A. § 2473):

- Annual registration fee - approx. 16 units annually
- Notice of solicitation filing fees – approx. 100 units annually

**Manufacturers of prescribed products gift expenditure disclosures** (18 V.S.A. § 4632) – approx. 120 units annually
