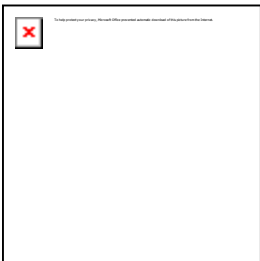
Please tell me why the committee is pushing this through without the complete forethought on the following:

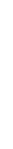
