That's why the state has proposed requiring that the entire boat, including ballast tanks, be decontaminated using hot water before launching on another lake. Moore downplayed the threat. Most of the wake boats in Vermont are based at a home lake and aren't typically towed from lake to lake, she said. And while aquatic invasive species transport is a real and important concern, she said, "the level of intensity and focus on this small universe of boats and the appreciable but not astronomical risk that they present is, I think, a red herring."
