


As of 2022...


- There were 7,633 horses and ponies in Vermont across 1,012 farms.
- 48% of VT Horse and Pony Operations operated on 1.0-49.9 acres of land.
- Sales of equine products in Vermont totaled \$1,087,000.
- Vermont ranked 44th out of all 50 states for number of horses and ponies.


Trend Analysis (2002-2022):




