

2024 ECONOMIC IMPACT OF VERMONT FAIRS

## NINE POSITIVE SIGNS OF GROWTH FROM TWELVE FAIRS!

- Attendance is up 9% to 354,371
- Nonprofits exhibiting went up 50% to 152
- Wages increased \$490,000 to \$1,885,141
- Volunteer numbers increased by 100 to 1365
- Volunteered hours increased from 32,000 to 50,000
- Fairs spending into their community held steady at \$2.1 million
- Marketing dollars spent went up \$52,000 to \$344,928
- Total yearly budgets increased \$786,000 to \$9 million
- Fairs increased the use of their facilities during the off season from 135 to 209 events!
- Gross income from the midway increased \$123,000 to \$2,120,504 resulting in an increase to the state sales tax of \$9,000
