

Impacts of Federal Funding

- \$4.75 million to VACD & NRCDs at risk
- \$3.6 million on hold:
 - \$2.3 million for staffing, technical assistance to farms
 - \$1.2 million for a culvert replacement in Essex County
 - \$40,000 for culvert replacements in Orleans County
- Tremendous uncertainty about USDA NRCD funding for FY25 and FY26







\$400,000 cancelled for workforce development to White River & Bennington County Natural Resources Conservation Districts


