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


Master Settlement Agreement (MSA)

- In 1998, 52 state and territory attorneys general signed the MSA with the four largest tobacco companies in the U.S.
 - Eventually, 45 tobacco companies settled
- The purpose is to reduce smoking in the U.S.
- Under the MSA, tobacco manufacturers that settled are obligated to make annual payments to states while they sell cigarettes in the U.S.

Trust Fund Outlook

- FY 2027 projected sources: \$18.67 million
 - \$17.26 million settlement funds
 - \$1.41 million prior year balance
- FY 2026 base appropriations: \$24.52 million
- \$18.67 million \$24.52 million = -\$5.85 million
 - Projected \$4.1 million at the end of FY 2026
 - Projected difference in available and source revenue: -\$1.75 million
