VERMONT'S NONPROFIT SECTOR:

AN ECONOMIC DRIVER & VITAL COMMUNITY PARTNER



Nonprofits employ 1 in 5 Vermont workers, making the nonprofit sector the largest industry in the state after the government.

More than 6300 Vermont nonprofits serve all corners of the state. With healthcare and education driving sector revenue, public charities generate more than \$10 billion.



Vermont nonprofits paid over \$3 billion in wages, which translates into an estimated \$34 million of personal income tax revenue for Vermont's state and local governments and over \$334 million in federal tax revenues.

Vermont nonprofits contribute \$5.7 billion per year to the economy through wages paid, retail and wholesale purchases, and professional service contracts. This contribution is equivalent to nearly 20% of the State's gross state product - greater than the manufacturing and construction industries combined.
