12	(2) Within 30 days following public notification of the resignation of a
13	Secretary of Education:
14	(A) the State Board shall initiate a robust national search process; and
15	(B) the Governor may issue a written letter to the State Board with
16	information regarding qualifications and experience the Governor would prefer
17	to see in potential candidates.
18	(3) The State Board shall send its list of not fewer than three candidates
19	to the Governor within 90 days after initiating a search pursuant to subdivision
20	(2)(A) of this subsection.

1	(4) The Governor shall appoint a Secretary of Education not later than
2	30 days after receiving the list of candidates from the State Board.
3	(5) The Secretary shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
4	(b) <u>Cabinet member</u> . The Secretary shall report directly to the Governor
5	and shall be a member of the Governor's Cabinet.
6	(c) Expertise and experience. At the time of appointment, the Secretary
7	shall have significant experience and expertise in:
8	(1) public education management and policy;
9	(2) curriculum development and classroom instruction; and
10	(3) demonstrated educational leadership and management abilities.
