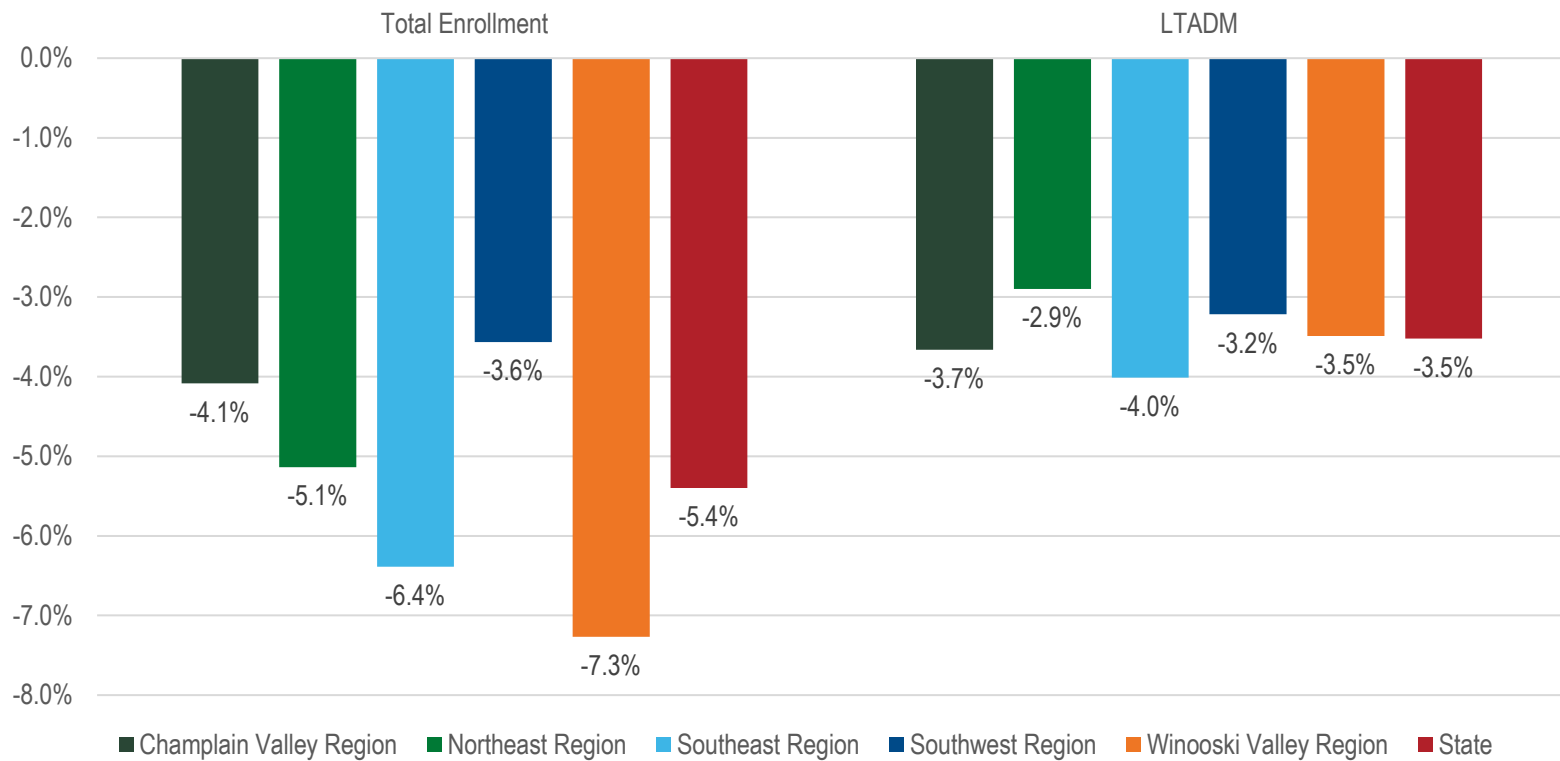

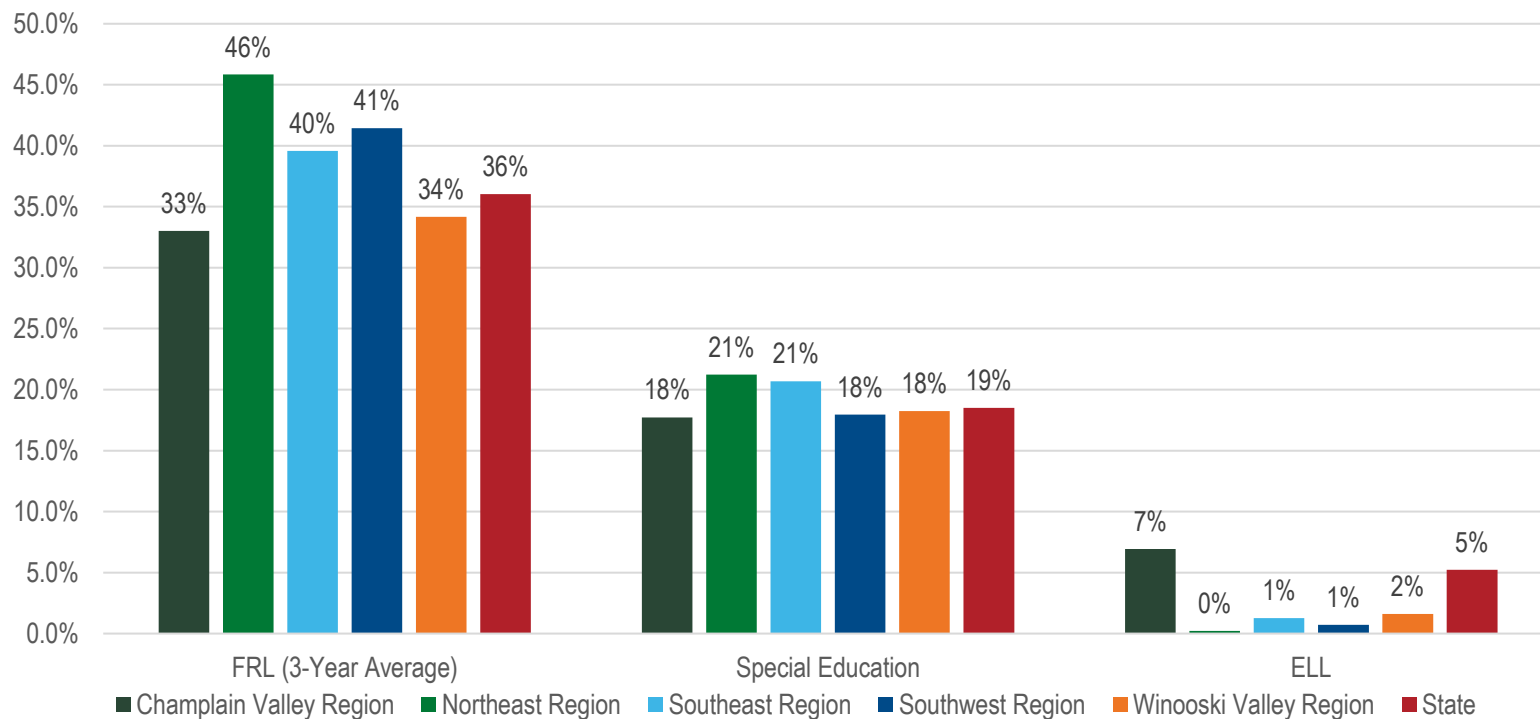

Total Enrollment and LTADM Change, 2019-20 to 2022-23

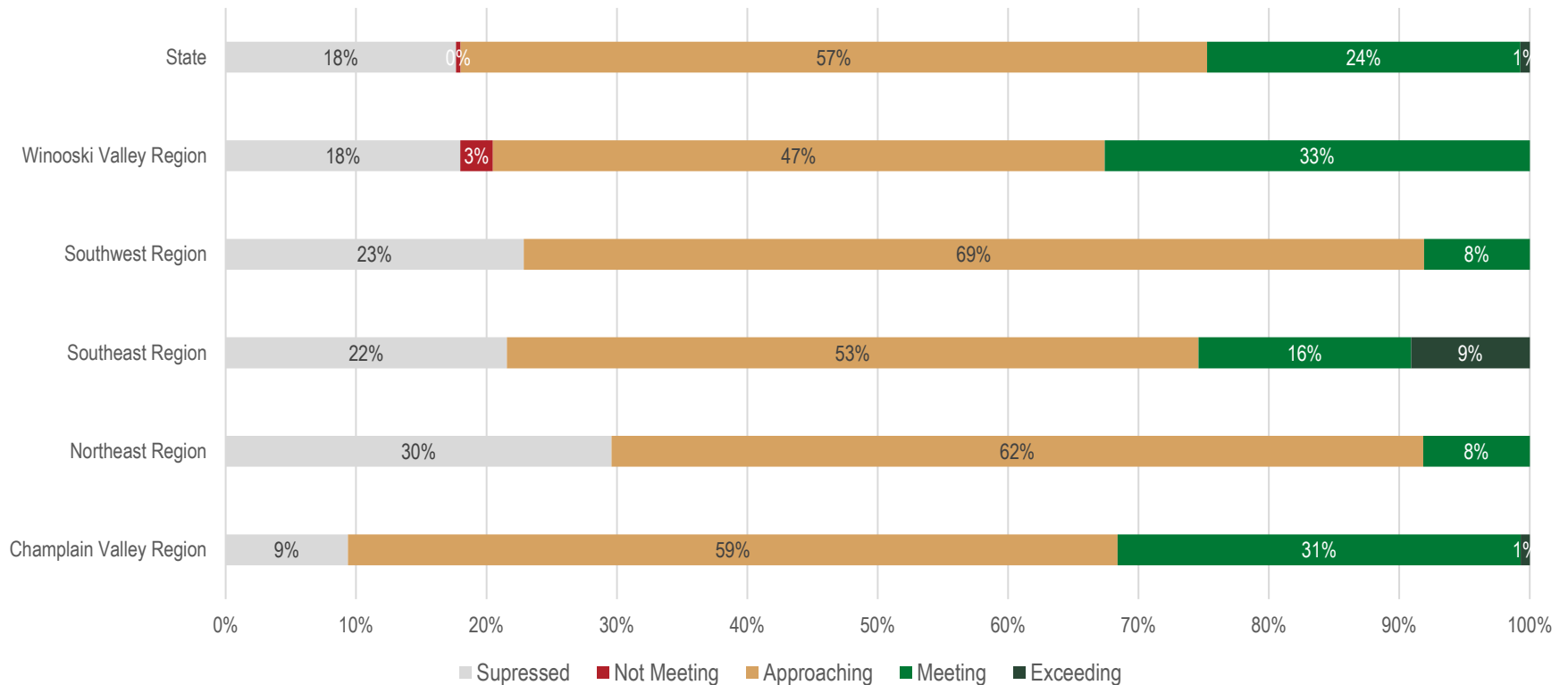

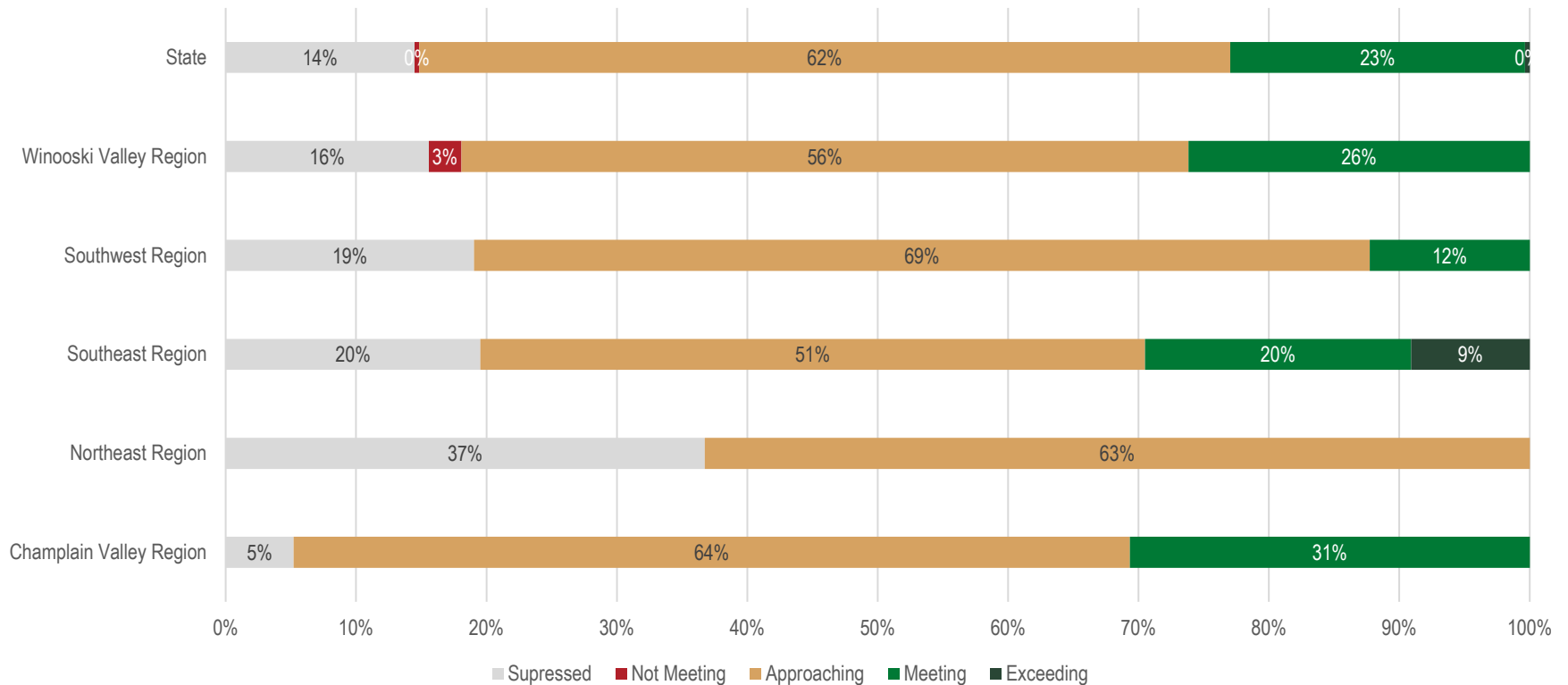

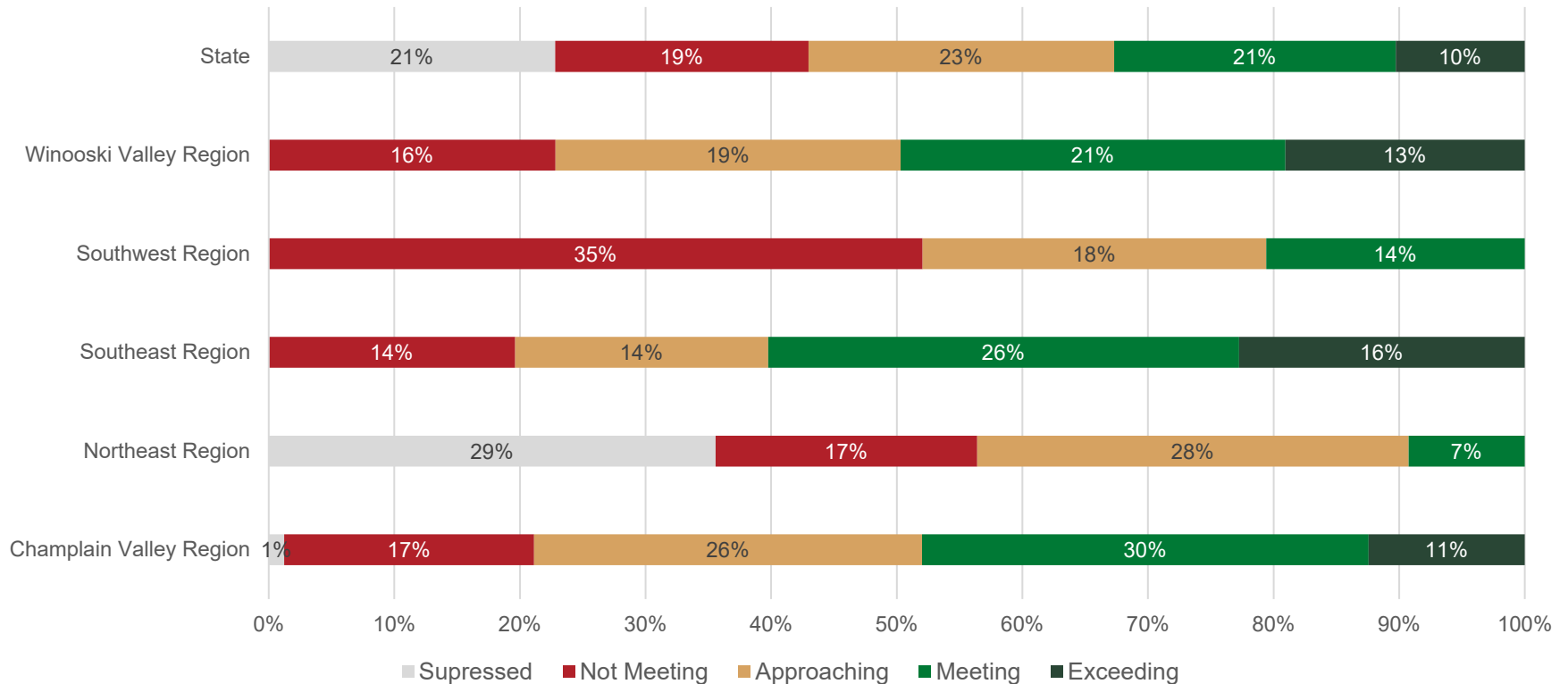
ELA (Overall) Academic Proficiency Ratings, 2022-23



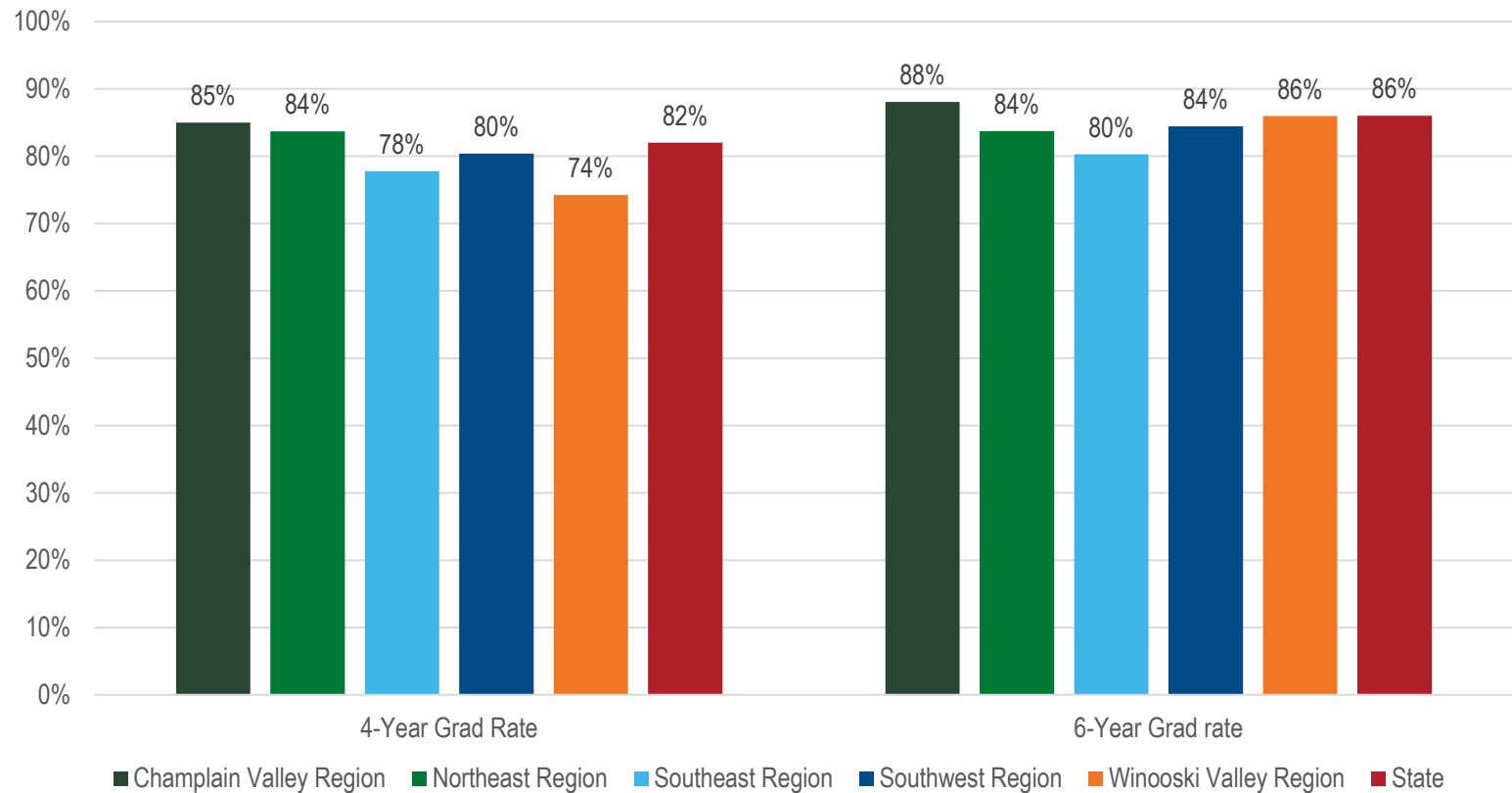
Math (Overall) Academic Proficiency Ratings, 2022-23



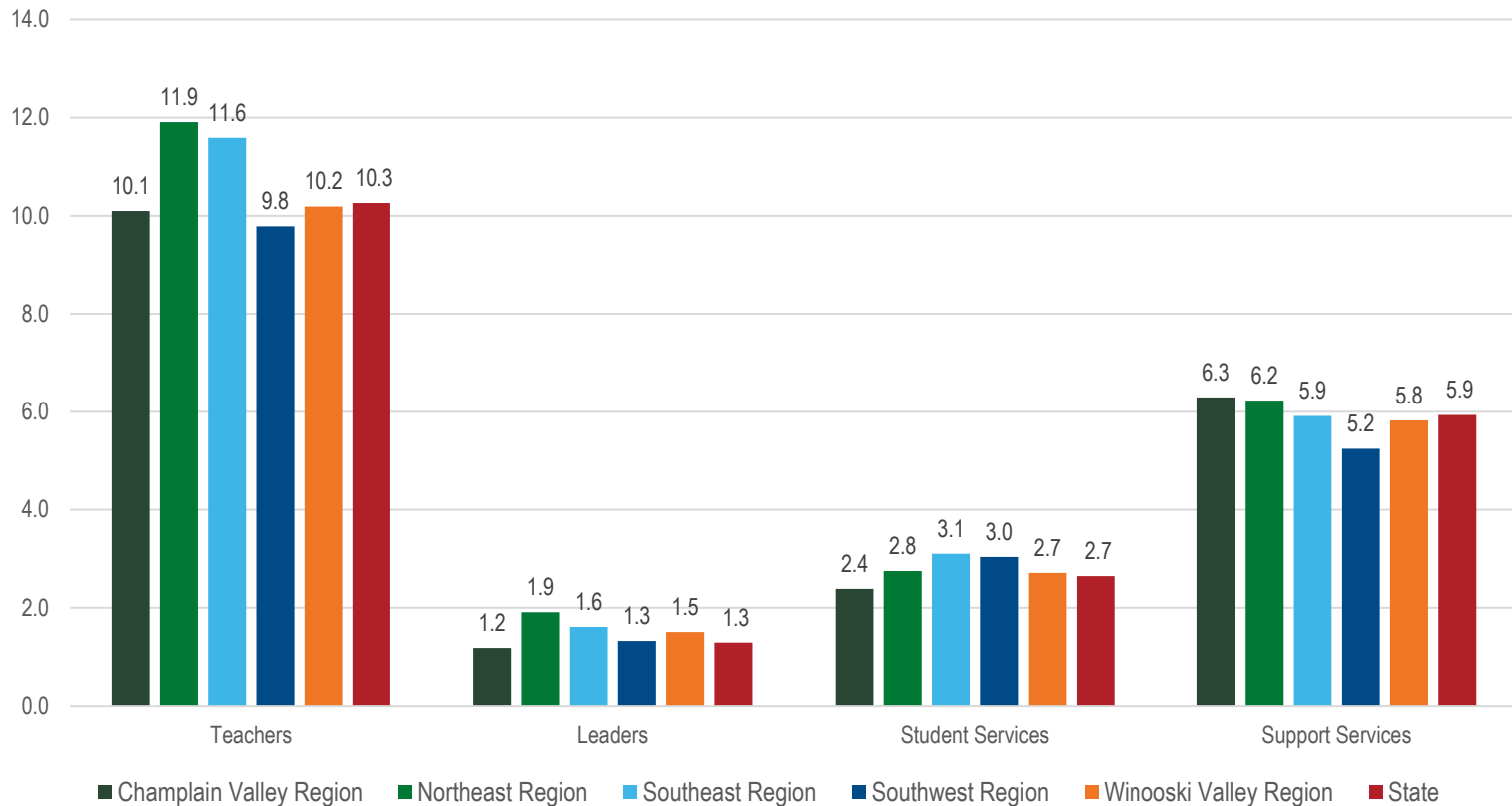
Science Academic Proficiency Ratings, 2022-23



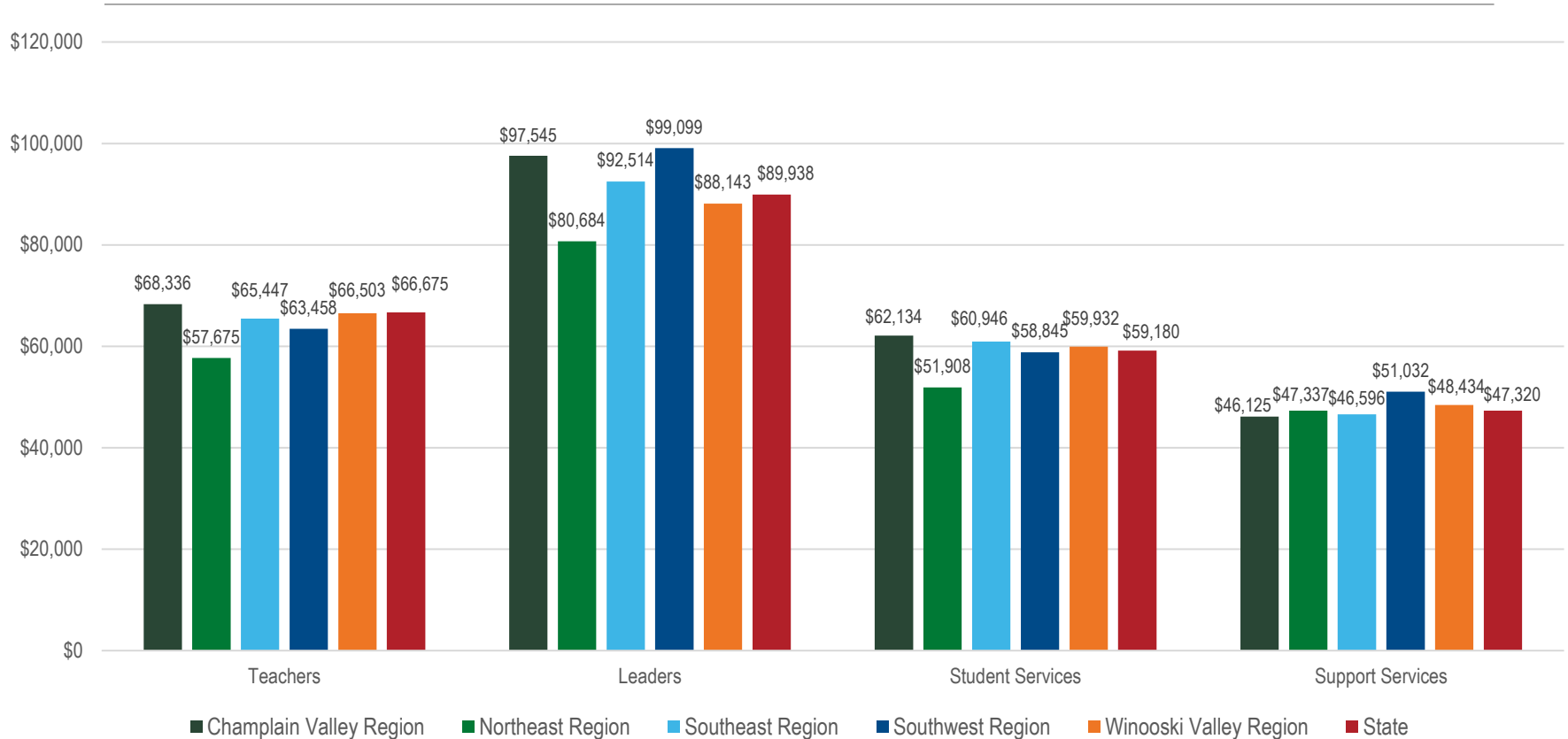
Graduation Rates, 2022-23



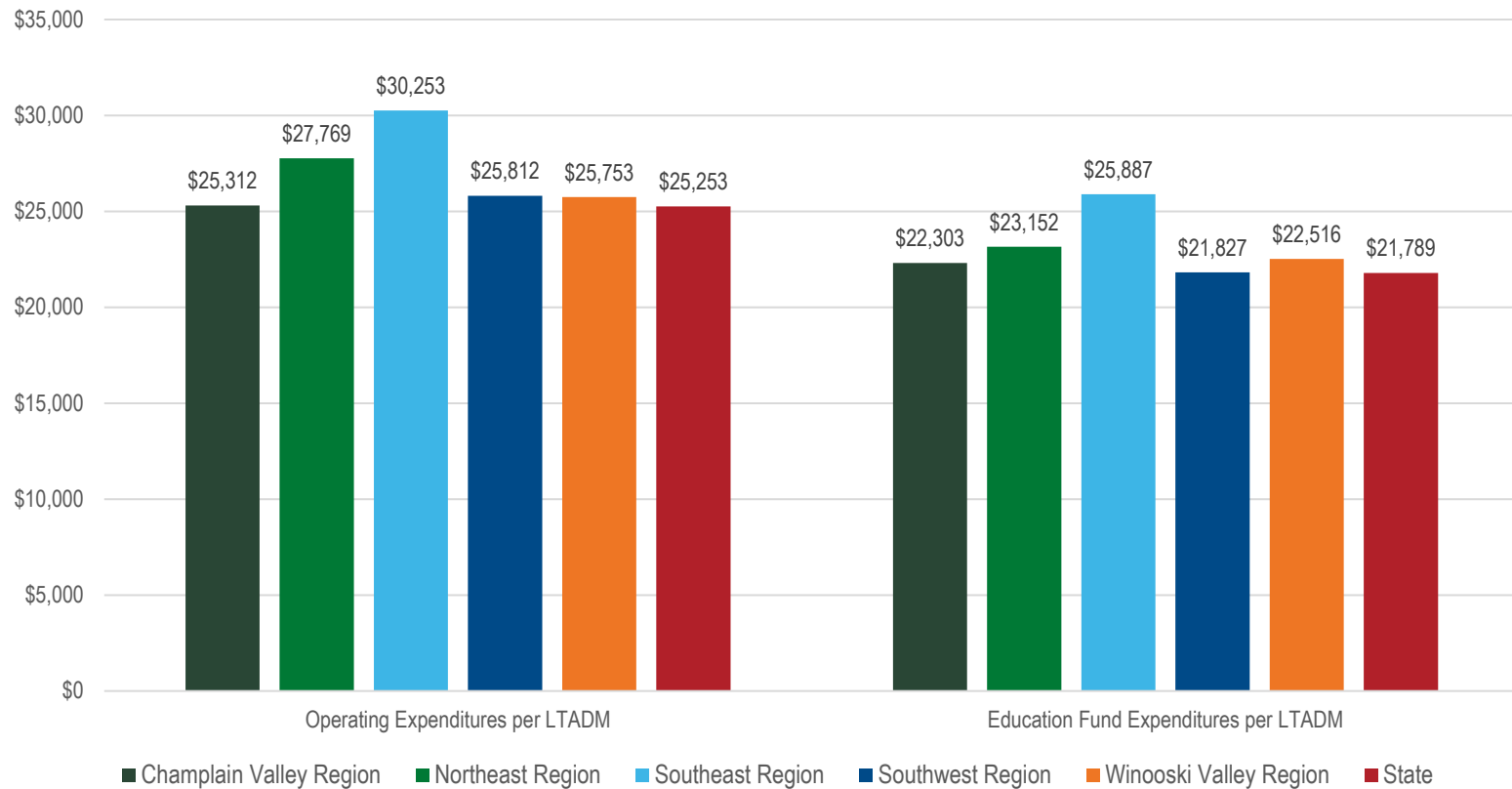
Staff Per 100 Students, 2022-23



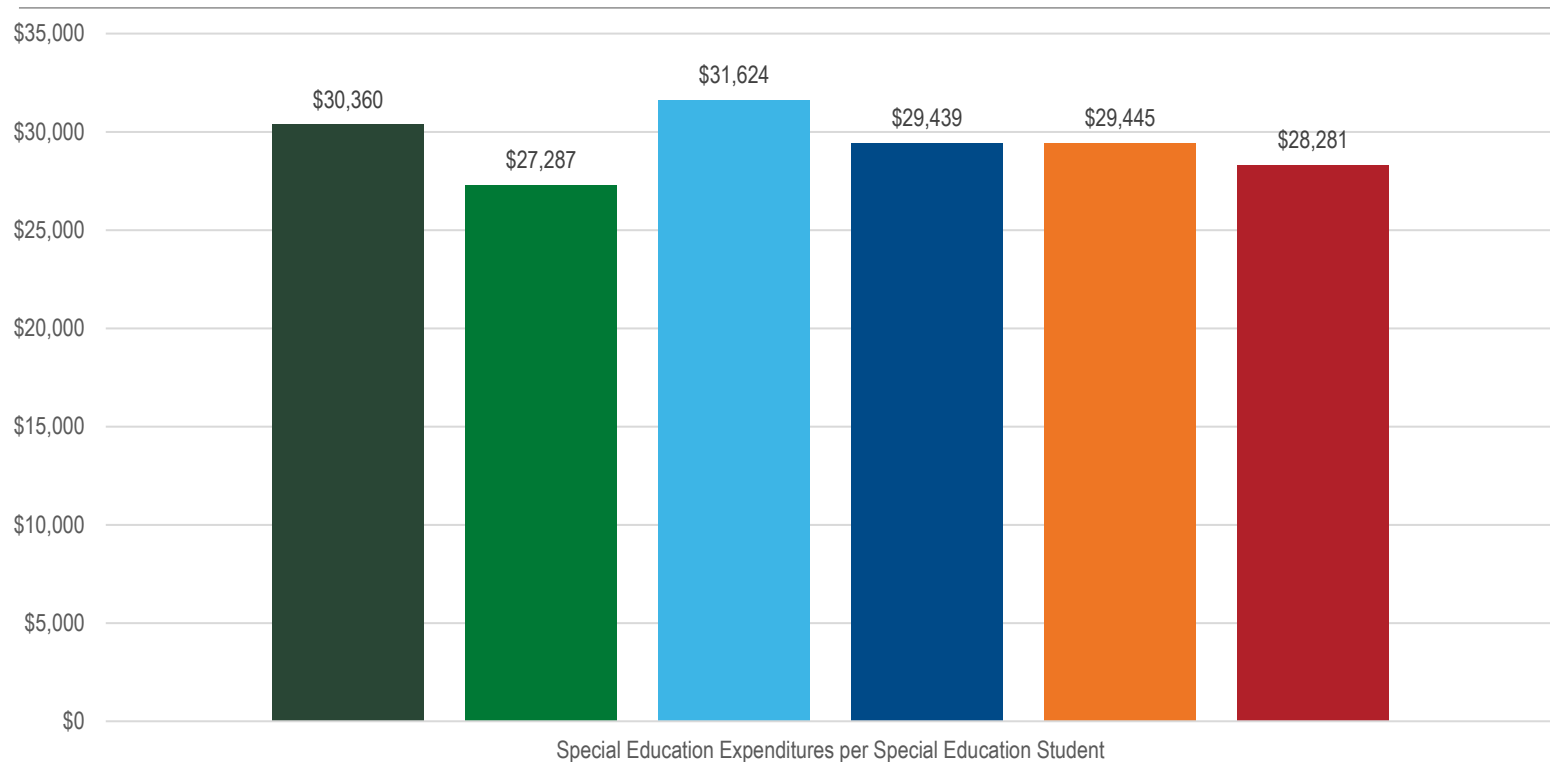
Average Salaries, 2022-23
