Under Vermont 16 V.S.A. 3448f (c)(3): "Voter approval of proposed performance contract. If the terms of the proposed performance contract permit the district to make payments to the contractor over a period of time exceeding 10 20 years, then the district shall not enter into a final performance contract until it receives approval from the electorate to do so."
